You Can Change a Life

A number of potential Songoro college students have applied to the scholarship program and are praying that patrons will step forward to support them.

College education is rare in Tanzania and most of these students are from subsistence farm families with annual incomes of \$500-\$600.

The All Saints – Songoro Scholarship Program has assisted 20 college graduates since its inception in 2005. College fees are typically \$1500-\$2000 per year. Most college programs are three years and patrons are asked to commit to financially support their student for their student's entire course of study. Applications that are forwarded to us by the partnership committee in Songoro have been reviewed and only those that have potential and need are sent. Applicants hope to pursue degrees in Medical Laboratory Sciences, Basic Education – Teaching Certification, Economics and Finance, and Business Administration.

Mt Meru Premium Coffee prices have remained the same since 2011 and much has changed since then.



There are several reasons for a price increase:

- 1. Costs have increased more than 30% over these 12 years.
- 2. New, young farmers need to be incentivized to grow coffee as a cash crop using the best sustainable practices available.
- 3. Growing PREMIUM coffee has ever increasing costs.
- 4. The focus of the Mt Meru Coffee Project is to improve the standard of living in the Meru Diocese in Tanzania.



Please think about your upcoming summer weddings, graduations, birthdays, retirements, etc. How about a summer party where you are bringing a hostess gift? Maybe think about getting a gift card you know they will use!

As you too start to plan your vacations, please consider getting gift card for your trips. We have gift cards available for most airlines,




Are you considering using Wayfair or Overstock.com for some updates—we sell those! Have you gone to the Marcus Theatre lately? We have those in stock too. They can be used for tickets as well as your popcorn and beverage! Summer project—Home Depot, Lowe's, ACE, Menards, Fleet Farm—we got those!

Do you own a business, or do you have an expense account for your job? Would you be able to buy physical gift cards or ecards to use for work? Think office supplies like those from Office Depot/Max, Target or Wal-Mart. How about gas for your vehicle from BP or Kwik Trip? Do you get equipment from Fleet Farm, Ace Hardware or Menards? How about that order you place periodically from Amazon? We can set you up with SCRIP cards for all of those businesses as well as many others.

There is a list of all current gift cards available on the bulletin board by the Scrip table. Check through the list to see if there are some you would like us to order for you. There are many that might surprise you and the rebates average 4-15% for ASLC!

You can also order gift cards online at <u>ShopwithScrip.com</u>. Please register a family account and use our ASLC enrollment code--**21E12A3876L8**. You will also need this code to set up an account on the RaiseRight app. There are some cards that are only available as e-cards and you would need to get the app to order and use those—like Airbnb or some airlines.

And there are additional bonuses for All Saints that are only available with the app. You can order on ...continues on next page

the spot and do not have to plan a week ahead. For example, if your hot water heater goes out, you can use RaiseRight to buy a Home Depot ecard in any amount (\$5 increment), get the ecard on your phone, and then head to Home Depot. Also, for most merchant cards ordered through RaiseRight, cards can be ordered in almost any amount. You can buy a Home Depot card for \$1,450, so you don't have to go through 15, \$100 cards. Your bank transfer costs \$0.15, no matter what the amount of gift card you order! There are close to 700 different companies which offer cards on the app. If you have any questions or need help with RaiseRight, feel free to talk to George Corliss or Rebecca Seevers as they both use the app often to buy needed cards.

We have enjoyed wonderful support by our congregation and ask that you continue to buy Scrip cards in the future. We want to continue making generous and greatly appreciated donations for missions in the future.
