
Tanzania Mission Presentation

Sunday, September 18th following Worship

All Saints supports two missions in Tanzania: **Songoro Lutheran Church & Mt. Meru Coffee Project.** All Saints has been Songoro's only partner congregation since 2005. Our partnership has assisted most Songoro students to attend secondary school, and patrons from All Saints have assisted 18 Songoro students to attend college. All Saints has also assisted in the construction and equipping of a clinic that is helping Songoro residents to avoid a 1 1/2 hour walk to receive health care.

Mt Meru Coffee Project has ambassadors in most Greater Milwaukee Synod congregations. This Fair Trade project has been importing PREMIUM coffee from the coffee farmers of the Meru Diocese. Paying a fair price to these farmers has been improving the standard of living in the Meru Diocese for 23 years.

This will be a fast paced event with time for comments and questions. We can all grab a cup of coffee in the kitchen and start the event 10 minutes after service ends.
