On December 29, 1890, as many as 300 Sioux, mostly unarmed and half of them women and children, were killed by 500 US soldiers of the 7th Cavalry. It is reported that Chief Big Foot was killed, as well as 25 US soldiers. This massacre is referred to as Wounded Knee.
