Pine Ridge Reservation

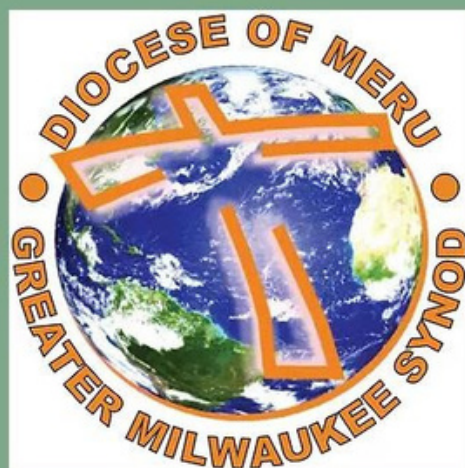

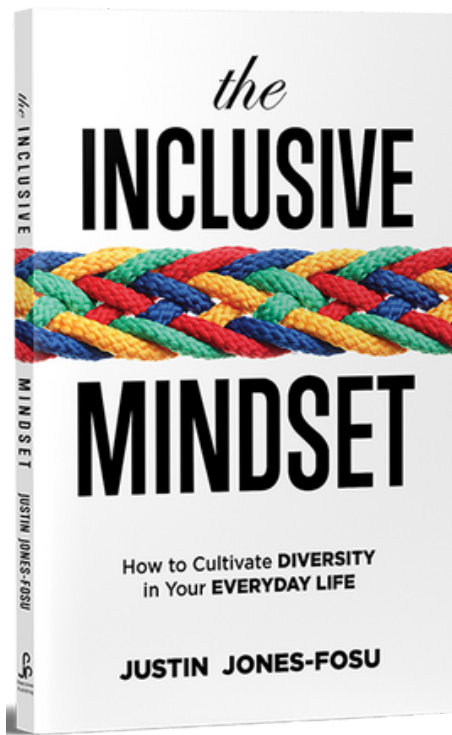
After the church service they will also be sharing additional information and answering questions for all that are interested.
