Sunday, October 10, began routinely for the worship team. Gary got the tech ready for online and in-person worship, Judy, Wendy and singers rehearsed, and Pastor Roy pulled all the things together to get ready for worship.

Then, shortly before the worship service was to start, we experienced a momentary power outage due to a fast-moving storm and lightening strike, and all Gary's tech set up had to be redone. This would have been little more than a hiccup, except the internet did not come back on ... so the livestream for online worship became an impossibility.

Kelly was off that morning, but Gary got him on the phone. They and Pastor Roy ran through their troubleshooting options and decided to record worship and post it later, after we had internet access.

We worshipped without our livestream attendees, hoping to get the service to them quickly. But after the service ended, the internet was still down.
