

¹³ Who is wise and understanding among you? Show by your good life that your works are done with

gentleness born of wisdom. ¹⁴ But if you have bitter envy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not be boastful and false to the truth. ¹⁵ Such wisdom does not come down from above, but is earthly, unspiritual, devilish. ¹⁶ For where there is envy and selfish ambition, there will also be disorder and wickedness of every kind. ¹⁷ But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without a trace of partiality or hypocrisy. ¹⁸ And a harvest of righteousness is sown in peace for those who make peace. ^{4:1} Those conflicts and disputes among you, where do they come from? 



Outreach for Hope 2021 Ride Run Walk

Join me and your friends Saturday Morning September 25 for the <u>Outreach for Hope Ride-Run-Walk</u> and help raise \$150,000 for central city congregations in the Greater Milwaukee Synod. Your dollars will support Ministries such as:

Food pantries, meal programs
Health and wellness clinics
Clothing pantries
Safe baby programs, clean water campaigns
Urban internships
After school programs and summer camps
GED and legal support
Drug and alcohol counseling

There are 4 event locations this year and the Waukesha County site is at Cory Park in Dousman. This location will feature road rides of 50 miles, 30 miles, and 20 miles; a bike trail ride of 14 miles (or whatever distance you are comfortable with); a 2 mile walk; and family picnic with kids' activities.
