Immigration Timeline

Permanent Residence Application through PERM (Program Electronic Review Management)-based Labor Certification Application Filed with the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL)

Month 1

After certification of the Permanent Labor Certification by the U.S. Department of Labor, Attorney files the Employer's I-140 immigrant visa petition with USCIS.

Month 2-10

I-140 is filed with Premium Processing, decision received within 15 days.

Month 3-12

Once the I-140 is approved, USCIS will send the case to the National Visa Center (NVC). Within 1-2 months, NVC sends "welcome letter." Marquis/PE Staffing will pay the immigrant visa fee online. This fee must be paid from a U.S. based bank account. Employee will then complete online U.S. immigrant Visa Application, Form DS-260, and provides to Attorney for review together with Civil Documents. Employee submits DS-260 online. Depending on the country, employee will either submit Civil Documents online, or Attorney will prepare Civil Document package and mail it to the NVC.

Month 7-12

Depending on the immigrant visa backlog at the U.S. Consulate abroad, the following steps may take place anywhere from 3 months to 12 months after the case is documentarily complete at the NVC:

1. Receive interview appointment letter at U.S. Consulate
2. If required by Consulate, employee (and any dependent family members) attend Biometrics Appointment for photo and fingerprinting
3. Employee and dependent family members must attend immigrant medical examination with panel physician when directed by the Consulate
4. Prepare and attend the Consular office interview
5. If visa approved, receive passport back with visa
6. Marquis/PE Staffing will pay USCIS immigrant fee of \$220
7. Entry to US
8. About 2 months later receive green card by mail
