2025: A YEAR OF CHURCH PLANTING AND MISSIONS

We declare 2025 to be a year focused on church planting and missions. The vision for Amazing Life Church this year is simple yet powerful: **"I will go and I will send."** This vision is inspired by the scripture from Romans 10:14–15:

"How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: 'How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!'"



As we embark on this mission, we are reminded of the urgency of reaching the lost and fulfilling the Great Commission. In Matthew 28:18–20, Jesus says:

“All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

The “going” part of the Great Commission cannot be overlooked. It is not enough to simply send others; each of us is called to go. Therefore, in 2025, we will create opportunities within our church for everyone to actively participate in going to the villages of Jharkhand. We hope that every member will seize the opportunities that arise to be a part of this mission.



CHURCH PLANTING AND SENDING WORKERS

As the early church actively sent workers into the harvest field, so will we in 2025. We aim to plant 10 new churches in different regions of Jharkhand, and we need the collective effort of our church to fulfil this mission.

The responsibility to reach the lost is shared by every member of the church. The vision of "**I will go and I will send**" means that both actions—going and sending—are essential. We are not just sending people to missions; we are all called to go, to pray, to give, and to support the mission in every way possible.

- **Praying:** Regularly lifting up these new churches and their leaders in prayer.

By doing so, we will be actively engaged in both sending and going, fulfilling the Great Commission together.
