Rules and Regulations

Eligibility selection criteria:

Applicants must be a graduate of any high school in the Shreveport-Bossier area.

Applicants must have a grade point average of 3.0 or better.

Applicants must complete a scholarship application.

Applicants must submit a short essay with application.

Applicants must be interviewed by Board of Directors.

Applicants must live in the Shreveport - Bossier area.

Additional Requirements

Persons applying for scholarships do not have to major in the art of theater for the semester for which the scholarship is granted. (*Applications are now accepted from all that apply.*)

To qualify for future scholarships, the recipient must maintain a GPA of 3.0 or above.

Recipients can apply for no more than four scholarships. (*One per school semester*)

If recipient does not maintain a GPA of 3.0 or above, the recipient will be disqualified for future scholarships for no less than two semesters.

Once the recipient has been selected, a check will be written in the name of the recipient and given to the recipient once the recipient is enrolled as a full-time student in the college of their choice. The recipient must provide proof of college enrollment.

If recipient does not complete the semester for which the scholarship was rewarded, recipient must refund to AOF the full amount awarded and will not be eligible for additional AOF scholarships.

The Selection Process

AOF Ministries Board of Directors will select which applicant(s) to be awarded a scholarship.

- Applicants will be interviewed by AOF Board of Directors.
- The Board will review each application and read each essay.
- The Board will cast votes to determine which applicant will receive the scholarship.
- The applicant with the most votes will be awarded the scholarship.
