



PUPPY PURCHASE AGREEMENT

Deposit

To hold a puppy, a \$200 deposit is required from the buyer. All deposits are non-refundable unless it is determined by the breeder (seller) that the new puppy has a medical condition that makes it unfit for sale.

Information Provided by Breeder (Seller)

The breeder (seller) will provide information on the puppy, including Litter Number, Sire and Dam's Name and Registration Numbers, Sex, Date of Birth and Color. The breeder (seller) will also provide information regarding initial vaccinations and de-worming as well as the food the puppy is currently consuming. The breeder (seller) will advise that the puppy be taken to a licensed and practicing veterinarian for an initial examination within 48 hours of physical transfer to the buyer. If available, a puppy registration form will be provided to the buyer at time of pickup. If not available at the time of pick up, a registration form will be mailed to the buyer as soon as one is available (usually 3-6 weeks).

Rights of the Breeder

The breeder (seller) has the right to cancel this agreement if the puppy is found to be unsound or if the buyer is determined to be unfit to own the puppy, at the breeder's discretion. The deposit will be refunded in either case.

Pick Up

A pickup date should be discussed and arranged at the time a deposit is provided for the puppy. If more than two days pass from arranged pickup date without contact from buyer, the deposit may be retained by the breeder (seller) and the breeder (seller) has the right to cancel the sale of the puppy.

Rights of the Buyer:

Should the puppy have any pre-existing medical condition revealed by an examination by licensed and practicing veterinarian within 48 hours of puppy pick up, the terms of the General Health Warranty (see page 2) will apply. If it is determined by a licensed and practicing veterinarian within twelve months of the puppy's date of birth, that the puppy has a life-threatening, genetic disorder, the terms of the Genetic Warranty (see page 2) will apply.

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General Health Warranty:

The new puppy is guaranteed to be in good health.

- ❖ To validate this guarantee, **the buyer must** have the new puppy examined by a licensed and practicing veterinarian within 48 hours of puppy pick-up and inform the breeder (seller) no later than 24 hours after the veterinary examination. In addition, **the buyer must** provide a copy of the examination results upon request by the breeder (seller). Failure to do so will result in cancellation of the General Health Warranty.
- ❖ **Ear mites, intestinal parasites and coccidia** are not serious problems, if treated, and are not covered by this warranty. **Hypoglycemia** (low blood sugar) is a serious health problem generally caused by too much activity and/or too little food. It is also excluded from this warranty because its causes are within the buyer's control.
- ❖ If notified, within 72 hours of puppy pick-up, that a licensed and practicing veterinarian has found the new puppy to have a serious health problem, and examination results are provided in writing, the breeder will replace the puppy with a healthy puppy of a similar kind when available. **The buyer must** promptly return the new puppy and the breeder's veterinarian must confirm the diagnosis.

Genetic Warranty:

The new puppy is warranted against any life-threatening genetic or hereditary disorders for twelve (12) months from date a birth.

- ❖ If notified, within twelve months of date of birth, that a licensed and practicing veterinarian has found the new puppy to have a life-threatening, genetic disorder (applies to the Genetic Health Warranty), and the veterinarian's findings are provided in writing, the breeder will replace the puppy with a healthy puppy of a similar kind when available. **The buyer must** promptly return the new puppy and the breeder's veterinarian must confirm the diagnosis. **Replacement Only. No Cash Refunds.**
- ❖ As a condition to the Genetic Warranty, in the event the puppy dies within twelve months of date of birth, the buyer must provide a written autopsy report from the University of Georgia Veterinary School labs in Athens or Tifton, Georgia confirming that a genetic defect was responsible for the death of the pet.

In connection with all the foregoing, under NO circumstances is the breeder (seller) responsible for any veterinarian medical expenses or other expenses incurred by the buyer. It is understood that there are no warranties, expressed or implied, to said puppy except as set forth in this agreement. It is further understood that the breeder does not guarantee the size of the puppy or puppies.

Feeding:

At the time of pick up, the breeder (seller) will inform the buyer of the food the new puppy is currently consuming. When changing food, the new food should be mixed with the sample food provided at pick up, slowly changing over to the new food. The breeder is not responsible for complications related to incorrect feeding. **Table scraps and cow's milk are strongly discouraged.**
