E&S Plan “Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan”

-Shows what the contractor needs to do during construction to keep the soil from washing off the site and onto the roads or neighboring properties or waterways.


These E&S measures are temporary and usually consist of items like silt fence or silt socks, which are removed after the grass on site is established.

Stormwater Plan “Stormwater Management Plan”

-Shows the permanent measures that need to be built on a site to slow the storm water down before it leaves the site.

These permanent measures usually consist of detention ponds, large rock pits, or large underground storage pipes where the stormwater can be stored and released slowly.
