Each day brings new chaos from the administration in Washington. We must do everything in our power to restore our democracy and **you** are indispensable to this effort.

**VOTE** in the March 17 Primary Election. Voting is a fragile privilege, and we must turn out in numbers too large to ignore to ensure we retain this right. In the last primary, only 20% of eligible voters in DuPage County made their vote count. We can do better.

### **Apply for a Vote by Mail Ballot**

Vote by Mail is safe, secure, and cost effective. Visit the Election Division site to apply. While you're there, sign up for BallotTrax. You'll receive notifications when your ballot is mailed, returned and accepted. Due to changes in the way the US Postal System is now postmarking mail, please return your ballot ASAP, or take it to the counter and ask to have it postmarked by hand. You may also return your ballot at any early voting location, at the drop boxes at the 421 County Building, or at any polling place on Election Day. The recent public forum about Vote by Mail is available on the election Division website.

### **Early Voting begins Thursday, February 5.**

Our most convenient Early Voting location is the DuPage County Fairgrounds on Manchester Rd. Additional locations will open March 2, and all polling locations will be open from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Election Day (Tuesday, March 17). Remember - you may vote anywhere in DuPage County.

Is everyone in your home registered to vote? If not, anyone who will be 18 by November 5 can do so online at the Election Division website or at [Vote.org](https://Vote.org)

## **Township Levy**

The following will appear on your ballot:

*Shall Milton Township be authorized to levy a new tax for purposes of acquiring machinery and equipment used in the construction, repair, and maintenance of roads and for constructing, or reconstructing buildings for housing machinery and equipment used in the construction, repair, and maintenance of roads, and have an additional tax of not to exceed .035% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property therein extended for such purposes?*

Basically, the Township is in need of a new building to replace one that is no longer viable. The new building would better protect expensive equipment and provide a safer working environment for the employees. Approximately \$600,000 would be shifted from the general road fund to this levy. The additional monies would be levied for two years, then the levy would be reduced to 2025 levels. Find more information at [miltonhighway.org](http://miltonhighway.org)
