Even if you do not want to file a police report, you can report the incident and request the incident number, which is documented in the system. When reporting suspicious activity, try to give the dispatcher the best description that you can. This will help responding officers to your neighborhood.

If you are witnessing a crime in progress or there is a threat to health/safety, call 9-1-1.
