Minutes of Meeting January 10, 2019

The meeting was called to order by DHMA President David Miranda at 6 PM.

Minutes of the December meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report as of December 31, 2018:

General Fund Net: \$ 705.50 (Assets less Liabilities – This will be carried over to CY 2019)
Classic Fund: \$ 3099.00 (It was \$3471 as of December 31, 2017)
Hole in One Fund: \$ 75.00 (Prepaid for CY 2019)

About 60 members have paid their CY 2019 dues to date. After January 31 unpaid members will be dropped from the GHIN system but can be reinstated (though perhaps with a time lag) once paid.

As of the end of December 2018 there were 156 men members and 13 women associate members. There were 157 men members and 14 women associate members at the end of December 2017.
