## Treasure's Report as of November 30, 2019:

General Fund Net:	\$ 1,448	(It was \$2,017 as of November 30, 2018)

Hole in One Fund:	\$ 560	(It was \$1,350 as of November 30, 2018)

- Thanksgiving Week Games:
  - The Tuesday and Thursday early games were moved to Tuesday and Wednesday, and that seemed to work well. The Wednesday game had about 16 participants.
  - The Black Friday game also went well. Need to get the signup sheet posted earlier next year. There were 23 participants.
- Christmas Toys for Needy Children. Still collecting new, unwrapped toys for boys and girls in grades 3-5.
- Saturday Tee Times. Currently Saturday morning DHMA tee times will have to be requested one week in advance to Elisha by the person running that game (or some other responsible person); as in calling for five tee times. This will be okay even if the actual tee times needed are plus or minus one. Actual tee times required need to be confirmed by Wednesday.

### **New Business:**

Rules Committee: The USGA will be adopting the new World Handicap System in 2020. There are a number of advantages to this new system and DHMA members are encouraged to look this up on the Internet as there are many articles that describe in varying detail the changes that are about to occur. George Waller, Jim Varner, and Don Lucas attended the FSGA Information Seminar on this new system at Eaglebrooke Golf Course in Lakeland on November 14<sup>th</sup> and provided the following information from that session: There are a number of changes, many designed to attract new golfers. A new player will need just three sores to have a

handicap, not five as currently required. Under the new system one's handicap will be based on the best 8 of 20 scores vice best 10 of 20. Handicaps will change daily and that may take some effort to implement. There are also new system provisions to account for adverse course conditions, to limit the number of strokes that may be counted on a hole
