- Jim Varner made an excellent presentation comparing the courses, management, and fees of the Bloomingdale and Heritage Isles courses. He developed an Information Sheet for each course and provided copies to attendees. These are attached to this email as pdf files.
- Jim conducted a Straw Poll of those attending. Results:
  - Stay at Diamond (leave the Association) - zero (0)
  - Travel league w/no home course - zero (0)
  - Any different course other than Bloomingdale or Heritage - zero (0)
  - Bloomingdale - eighteen (18)
  - Heritage - nineteen (19)
  - Basically a 50/50 split
- (Added) The plan going forward is to continue to look at these courses through the balance of August and September, playing them as often as possible, and to continue to collect information and feedback that will be discussed at the September meeting and voted upon at the October meeting.

### Other Business:

- Thanks to Tat Tattrie for temporarily storing the Association's supplies, equipment, trophies, and plaques. This saves further storage fees.


