## **New Business:**

# **Tournament Committee (Chaired by James Kasch):**

The 2023 Classic event will be held on two different days next year. Thursday, January 12th will be for the weekday players. This event will be held at Bloomingdale Golfers Club. The weekend players event will be held on Saturday, January 14th. The location for this event is TBD.

Note: Players are eligible to play in both events for "skins and pins," However, players are able to cash in the "Classic" money one time.

## **1-2-3 Tournament** will be held on February 25th.

**Masters (2023):** This will be a two-day event held on April 8th and April 15th. This event will have both and A and B flight with winners in each flight. To qualify, you must have placed either first or second in a stroke play event since the 2022 Masters, or been the winner from the previous year.

Other Business: An extended discussion took place regarding the issue of members who have not reached the required points quota to play in the Classic. A motion was introduced where members who have reached at least 50 points by the end of Dec 2022 and have attended one or more 2022 Quarterly meetings would have the option to pay \$5.00 per point to reach Classic qualified status. **The motion was passed.**
