Committee Reports:

Executive Council:

Membership dues for the 2022 season (\$40 + \$5 optional hole in one pot) are payable at the 11 December monthly meeting. The board requests payment prior to 31 December 2021 to ensure membership does not lapse mid-January 2022.

The 2022 Board Member elections will be held on 11 December at the Monthly Membership Meeting. Nominations for positions are due no later than December 1. A member wishing to run for a board position should make every effort to attend the 11 December meeting.

Rules Committee: Once again, we are reminded that members need to be aware of where they are teeing off with regards to the appropriate tee markers. Attention should be paid to those tee markers that are **NOT** parallel on the tee box. A friendly reminder to your fellow member should he not be in compliance with the tee markers would be appreciated. **NOTE:** The first group teeing off in a BGC event has the right to "square up" the markers.

Handicap Committee: The committee provided a clarification that during an event a hole where a member indicates an "X" on their scorecard needs to be posted as a net double bogey on the GHIN system.

Classic Points: Members are reminded that 60 points and attendance at two monthly meetings as a minimum are required to participate in the Annual Classic Tournament. A maximum of 30 points are allowed from meeting attendance.

Other Business: A motion was introduced and subsequently approved that a member running a BGA Tournament have their entry fee waived for said tournament. The motion was carried with unanimous approval. This directive will start in calendar year 2022.

Vice President Kasch introduced a motion that beginning in 2022, monthly membership meetings be held on a quarterly basis. Further discussion will take place on this topic.

The issue of member's "ball hawking" during club events was raised. The potential for this activity to have a negative impact on pace of play was noted. It is requested that member's conduct this activity outside of any of our events.
