Champagne production skyrocketed from 300,000 to 20 million bottles per year between 1800 and 1850, as the world started ordering more for ship christenings and New Year's celebrations.

Ancient Romans are credited with the kissing tradition because of their Saturnalia festival. It was a celebration honoring Saturn, the god of time.

NSIA LEGISLATURE REPORT By Ken Brauer

The 108th Nebraska Legislature, First Session, is scheduled to convene January 4, 2023. If you have never checked out the Nebraska Unicameral website, go to nebraskalegislature.gov and you will find links to literally anything you want to know about our State Legislature. Everything from a list of the 2023 Senators-Elect, the 2023 Tentative Legislative Session Calendar, Operative Dates for Bills Enacted During the 2022 Session, Hearing Schedules, Committee List, and State Senator List (just to name a few of the links).

When is the last time you have contacted your State Senator? There is also a link to find your Senator along with their contact information. Let them know what your concerns are about any legislative issues and also let them know if there are issues that they did a great job of dealing with in the legislature. I know they appreciate the good comments as well as knowing what concerns you and also your clients.

At the NSIA Board meeting on November 3, 2022, the Board renewed our lobbying contract with Mueller-Robak. Matt Schaefer, with Mueller-Robak, gave a report to the board on the activities of the last legislative session and some issues to be addressed in the upcoming session. Matt was asked about information on property tax credits and he provided me with the link to a news release from the Nebraska Department of Revenue at <u>https://</u>revenue.nebraska.gov/sites/revenue.nebraska.gov/files/doc/Real_Property_Tax_Credit_2018_9_-15-2022.pdf_. Information on the Nebraska School District Property Tax_Credit Look-up Tool is expected to be available on their website by January 31, 2023.

NSIA continues to monitor the activities of the Nebraska Legislature and the State Board of Accountancy on behalf of our members since our membership consists of both non-licensed accountants and CPA's.
