

From Fr. Mike's Desk

This week's Gospel reading continues where last week's left off. If you will recall, Jesus sends the Apostles out two by two to preach the Good News, and He gives them a share in His power and authority to cast out demons and heal the sick. Jesus gives this very same power to His Church as He ascended into Heaven. In fact, last week's Gospel passage shows Jesus' plan for what the Church is to do long before the events which took place on the first Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.

In this week's account, the Apostles returned from their preaching, driving out demons and healing the sick, and they were very tired, yet they were also very excited. They could not wait to get back to Jesus and tell Him all that they had done. Likewise, Jesus was excited to hear all they did in His name. "Tell me all about it", Jesus said to them, "and let us go off to a place where we can be alone and rest". However, as the Gospel hints, the Apostles were so successful, that more people came to believe in Jesus and wanted more than just hearing about Him, they wanted to see Him. Picture the mixed emotions that Jesus experienced, for He wanted to go off with the Apostles, but He could not leave the people, for they were like sheep without a shepherd. Jesus is surely the shepherd that Jeremiah spoke about in our first Jesus does what any good shepherd reading. would do, He cares for the sheep. Remember if our Lord did that for people 2018 years ago; think about how much He does for us from His place in Heaven. Think of how much more Jesus cares for His sheep through His living body the Church, and through the shepherds appoints over His Church. Keep in mind that we are all to shepherd and care for another. one

Remember our Annual Summer Festival coming up less than a month from now. This promises to be a great event. There will be rides, games, food, music, car show and fireworks on Saturday night. Come out and

have a wonderful time with your parish family and all our neighbors. See you there!

Also, remember the 2018 Catholic Ministry Appeal as we still have to raise more to meet our goal of \$113,000. When we meet our goal, we will receive a rebate of over \$25,000, which will allow St. Edward's to shepherd the people of Syosset. There is still time to donate to this very worthwhile appeal.

There is still available space in several grades of our beautiful St. Edward's School, and if you are considering a change in your child's or grandchild's education, or if you know a friend who is looking for something different and better for their children consider a Catholic education. Let us pray: God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, though your people walk in a valley of darkness, no evil should they fear; for they follow in faith the call of the shepherd whom you sent for their hope and strength. Attune our minds to the sound of His voice and lead our steps in the path He has shown. We ask this in the name of Jesus the Good Shepherd. Amen.





Religious Education Registration Info for the 2018-2019 School Year

<u>Families who are new to the Religious Education Program</u> may print out a New Family Registration Form from our web site at www.saintedwardre.com. Click on <u>Forms to Print</u>. It is a two-page form, so please be sure to print both pages. You may also choose to register online by selecting the link: <u>On-Line Registration for NEW Families</u>. We do ask, however, that all new families kindly contact the office by either calling 921-8543 or by emailing the Director at rpettei@st-edwards.org to arrange an appointment to meet with her. Mrs. Pettei will fill you in about the program here at St. Edward's.

St. Edward Religious Education is an 8-year formation program. Public School Students start in grade 1 and finish classes in grade 8. Our Kindergarten session is optional. Preparation for First Holy Communion takes place in grades 1 and 2. Students receive their First Holy Communion in May of grade 2.

Grades 3 through 6 are continuation years in students' religious education studies. Preparation for Confirmation takes place in grades 7 and 8. Students receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of grade 9.
