From Fr. Mike's Desk

St. Paul tells us in today's Letter to the Ephesians to watch carefully how we live and to be wise making the most of every opportunity to be with God. To look always to do good, because the power of evil is always present. The reading from the Book of Proverbs tells us to come and rest in the house that Wisdom has built, and eat the food that Wisdom has prepared carefully and lovingly. Forsake all foolishness so you may live with God and do what is good. Wisdom, using her gifts and opportunities are what we should contemplate this weekend as we continue *the Bread of Life Discourse in John's Gospel*.

We pick up the gospel account where last week's ended with the people quarrelling among themselves as to how can Jesus give them His flesh to eat? Again, if you do not realize who is offering His flesh and blood, and do not have faith in Him, this would indeed seem impossible. In fact, detractors of the faith used this statement by Our Lord during the time of the Roman Empire to accuse Christians of being cannibals (as they accused the Church of eating the flesh of others and seeking human sacrifices). Many of the Church Fathers, who were called *apologists (those who explain the faith to those outside of it)*, would write how these words were misunderstood, and they explained that what was eaten at the Mass was the Body and Blood of Jesus given to us in real food. Real food and drink, which keeps its appearance of bread and wine, but now has become the Body and Blood of Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit. The real food that Jesus gives us is unlike any other food we will ever eat. This food leads us to the Father and Eternal Life. As Jesus said, *"Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever."*

Wisdom sets her table and invites us to come and not to remain foolish. Be wise and take advantage of this opportunity that God gives us, eat the food which gives true life, and do not let the wisdom of this world tell you how to live. **There is only one true wisdom**, it

comes from God, and is given freely to us by the Father through the Son, and the working of the Holy Spirit.

A very special thank you to all who worked at the Parish Festival and all who came to share the fun and food. **Thanks to the Gorman Council of the Knights of Columbus** for spearheading the project and making sure everyone had a good time. A very special thank you to **the Town Of Oyster Bay** who was especially kind in allowing St. Edward's to hold its Annual Festival in its usual location. We could not have done it without the Town's help. Moreover, thanks to the entire Syosset Community for your patience and support.

Please remember our beautiful Saint Edward's School if you are looking for a great place to send your children or grandchildren to learn all they can about this world and the world that is to come. 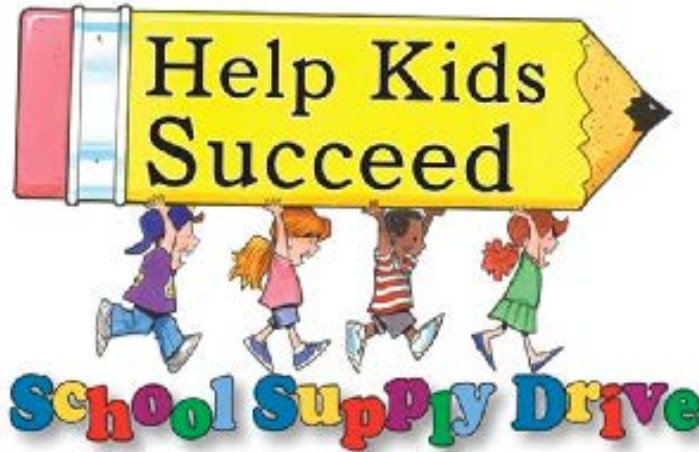


Religious Education Registration Info for the 2018-2019 School Year

Families who are new to the Religious Education Program may print out a New Family Registration Form from our web site at www.saintedwardre.com. Click on Forms to Print. It is a two-page form, so please be sure to print both pages. You may also choose to register online by selecting the link: On-Line Registration for NEW Families. We do ask, however, that all new families kindly contact the office by either calling 921-8543 or by emailing the Director at rpettei@st-edwards.org to arrange an appointment to meet with her. Mrs. Pettei will fill you in about the program here at St. Edward's.

St. Edward Religious Education is an 8-year formation program. Public School Students start in grade 1 and finish classes in grade 8. Our Kindergarten session is optional. Preparation for First Holy Communion takes place in grades 1 and 2. Students receive their First Holy Communion in May of grade 2. Grades 3 through 6 are continuation years in students' religious education studies. Preparation for Confirmation takes place in grades 7 and 8. Students receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of grade 9.
