

#### From Fr. Mike's Desk

Saint James writes in today's Epistle; "My brothers and sisters, show no partiality as you adhere to the faith...For if a man with gold rings and fine clothes comes into the assembly, and a poor person in shabby clothes also comes in, and you pay attention to the one wearing the fine clothes and say, 'Sit here, please,' while you say to the poor one, 'Stand there,' or 'Sit at my feet,' have you not made distinctions among yourselves and become judges..."

St. James is very clear that we are not to judge a book by its cover, or in this case a person by their appearance. We are not to favor the rich and well dressed and ignore or put aside the poor and shabbily dressed. He tells us that if we do this we are judging in a way that is contrary to the Gospel, as he writes, "with evil designs". The assembly, James is telling his audience, is open to all who Christ calls to the new life of the Resurrection. For His call comes to all regardless of their station in this life. Likewise, if we judge only by outward appearances we may believe that a poor person is lazy or lacking intelligence and cannot make a real contribution to the assembly of any kind. course, all of these impressions could be incorrect, and any impressions we may have about the man in fine clothes could be incorrect. We cannot possibly know a person until we really get to know the person. We cannot judge a person's abilities until we give that person a chance to learn and show us. This is especially true when it comes to the preaching of the Gospel and the building up of the Kingdom of Heaven. As it was true 2,018 years ago, so it is today!

Today Jesus is directly giving us this lesson when He heals the man who cannot hear and who has a speech impediment. As always, there is more to this healing miracle than meets the eye or in this case the ears. As we read the account, people brought this man to Jesus and begged Him to heal the man. Jesus took the man off by himself and carried out the miracle, in a rather earthy way. Immediately the man's ears were opened and his impediment was removed. Jesus carried out this miracle in the district called the Decapolis (the ten Greek Cities). This was outside of Jewish territory and its inhabitants for the most part were pagans. While they may have known about God and heard about Jesus, they did not have a true belief in the

One, True God. However, since Jesus was a great person of interest, the man's companions brought him to Jesus.

The man's origins does not interest Jesus, and He will not waste any opportunity to spread the Good News, so He heals the man. After all how can this man spread the Good News if he cannot speak, how will these cities become one with the Church if they do not see the Gospel at work before their eyes. Many people of Jesus' time felt that the Messiah should not go outside Israel to heal and preach. They judged the people there as unworthy and God forsaken. As we see, Jesus did not judge these people by their cover, and it is just to these people and to our ancestors that He commands the Church to go after. We see this in Mathew's Gospel just as He is ascending into Heaven. Jesus tells the Apostles to go forth to every nation proclaiming the Good News and to baptize in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

So if we come away with anything today it should be, do not judge a book or a person by their cover, in fact do not judge at all. Rather, be open to all God presents you with and spread the Gospel. This is not always easy, but we can and will gain so much from it.






