



From Fr. Mike's Desk

"I gave my back to those who beat me, my checks to those who plucked my beard, my face I did not shield from buffets and spitting. The Lord God is my help...See the Lord God is my help; who will prove me wrong?"

"He began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer greatly...Then Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him. At this, He turned around and looking at His disciples rebuked Peter and said; 'Get back behind Me Satan. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do.'"

If we put ourselves in Peter's place we might say, well how else am I supposed to think, since I am a human being? Or if we were to speak to Isaiah, we might say how can the *Suffering Servant* believe that God is his constant help? None of this makes sense, for if you are suffering, how is God your help, and if you are the Messiah how can you die on the Cross, this is not supposed to happen to the chosen one! NO, none of this makes sense, but to God it makes perfect sense, and for us it is the best thing that could ever happen.

Isaiah's Suffering Servant, has always been viewed by the Church, as a vision of what the Messiah would have to endure. Of course, this could not properly be understood until the events of the Lord's Passion. Through it all, the Servant knew God was with Him and knew that what the Father planned for His Christ would free us from sin and death. All that the Father planned would allow us to enter into the new life of the Resurrection. Bear in mind that these events are not restricted to 2,018 years ago, they are made present each time we celebrate the Eucharist, each time we baptize someone, and hopefully each day of our lives as we offer ourselves to God. As Jesus says, "Whoever wishes to come after Me must deny himself, take up his cross and follow **Me.**" This is what we must strive to do always. We must strive to die to sin in the areas of our lives that keep us from freely being with Jesus in this life and in the next.


In the film *The Ten Commandments*, the character *Sephora*, Moses' wife, and played by *Yvonne De Carlo*, tries to comfort Moses in his misery over the slavery of his people in Egypt, by telling him that God must have a reason for allowing the slavery to continue. She tells him, who can know the mind of God? What she was

saying is, can we judge God, because neither Moses, Sephora, Joshua, Ramses II, or even Nefertiti could know what God https://www.nee.goo.com/hag. in mind, for God gave us a share in the Divine Plan. That share in none other than Our Lord, Jesus Christ. The Gospel and the power and grace of the Holy Spirit remind us daily of the great revelation of God to humanity, which is Jesus. We know that God is always with us, we know what He has called His Church to do, and we know that we, like the Suffering Servant, must take up our cross every day. We know as stated above, that we are to die to sin and strive to rise to new life always.

This weekend we celebrate Catechetical Sunday, and during this week, we honor all those in our parish who share their faith with our young people through our *Religious Education Program* and our *Youth Ministry Program*. We also honor those who share their faith with adults who are preparing to enter into the Church or receive sacraments they could not as younger people through our *RCIA Program*. Please keep these wonderful people and their students in your prayers.

Goals for the 2017-2018 School Year

St. Edward the Confessor School

Dear Parents/Guardians,

I hope that your child(ren) had a great first week of school; I most certainly did! The teachers and I were excited to see the excitement on our students' faces. As we enter our first full week of school, I wanted to share with you some of our school goals for this year!

As a School, our list of Goals for the 2017-2018 School Year include:

- Implementing our new Foreign Language Program using Rosetta Stone.
- ◆ Developing a stronger approach for teaching ELA, using the Columbia Teachers College Readers and Writers Workshop model in our elementary school grades.
- Provide more diverse opportunities for children to participate in After-School activities.
- Implementing our PBIS plan through the instruction of the Leader in Me program and our current Bucket Filling program.
- From September 2018 to June 2019, 80% of students in grades 4-8 (80 students) will improve at least one level on the Algebra and Algebraic Expression subtest on the I-Ready exam.
- ◆ From September 2018 to May 2019, 75% of faculty members will participate in at least 8 programs using Formed.
- From September 2018 to May 2019, we will increase our current retention rate in Early Childhood (50% 40/80 2017/2018) to 70% (52/75 2018—2019)
- Introduce our Parents to the Parish initiative of Formed.
- Increase parent participation in both volunteering and fundraising.

I want to thank Mr. Patricio, and our Cleaning crew for the amazing job they did in preparing our school for the first day of school. Hours and hours of hard work went into preparing our building for the first day of classes and as usual the building shines.

Meet the Teacher Night will be Wednesday, September 12, 2018. We welcome all families to come to the school and meet your child's teacher(s) and hear what is in store for this year from Mr. Albrecht, Father Mike, and PASE, Meet the Teacher Night will invite parents of students in grades K-4 to visit their child's classrooms starting at 6:00 p.m. We will have two sessions: one from 6:00 - 6:25 pm and another from 6:30 - 6:55 pm. At 7:15 pm, parents of students who are in grades 5-8 will gather in their child's homeroom, where they will then follow a modified schedule, so they can meet all of their child's teachers. I will give a brief general presentation at both 6:30 and 7:30 in the cafeteria. I look forward to seeing you all on Wednesday night!

May Jesus and the Holy Spirit protect and guide the students, staff, and parents of St. Edward the Confessor School as we encourage each to be the gifts that God intended us to be to one another.


Lectors help to proclaim the Word at Mass through the first and second readings. They read once to twice a month, and practice their public speaking while helping us all to pray. Grade 8+



Religious Education Registration Info for the 2018-2019 School Year

<u>Families who are new to the Religious Education Program</u> may print out a New Family Registration Form from our web site at www.saintedwardre.com. Click on <u>Forms to Print</u>. It is a two-page form, so please be sure to print both pages. You may also choose to register online by selecting the link: <u>On-Line Registration for NEW Families</u>. We do ask, however, that all new families kindly contact the office by either calling 921-8543 or by emailing the Director at rpettei@st-edwards.org to arrange an appointment to meet with her. Mrs. Pettei will fill you in about the program here at St. Edward's.

St. Edward Religious Education is an 8-year formation program. Public School Students start in grade 1 and finish classes in grade 8. Our Kindergarten session is optional. Preparation for First Holy Communion takes place in grades 1 and 2. Students receive their First Holy Communion in May of grade 2.

Grades 3 through 6 are continuation years in students' religious education studies. Preparation for Confirmation takes place in grades 7 and 8. Students receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of grade 9.



This Sunday, Sept. 16th at the 9:30 am Family Mass, the parish family of Saint Edward's, acknowledges, blesses and gives thanks for the faithful service that our catechists, as teachers of the Faith, provide for our young people. This Church community in Syosset will continue to flourish for years to come because of their dedication and commitment to teaching the Faith to our young. 
