

From Fr. Mike's Desk

Today we see jealousy and fear at work in the readings from Numbers and Mark's Gospel. In Numbers, Joshua is jealous because Eldad and Medad, who missed the call to go to God's gathering, also began to prophesize when God sent the spirit upon the 70 elders who attended the gathering. Joshua felt that they should not have been allowed to do so because they were absent from the gathering and in a sense defied Moses. Yet, Moses tells Joshua not to be upset on his account, after all, they were on the list of those chosen by God to share Moses' burden of leading and ministering to the people. Moses tells Joshua that he is thinking wrongly, and not to be jealous because it would be a wonderful occurrence if all the people would cry out to the Lord! Moses is telling Joshua to think outside of the box.

Jesus tells John and the others also to think differently and not to be jealous or fearful for His sake. The fear comes from a common belief during the time of Jesus that people could drive out demons by using the name of someone more powerful (whether it is a more powerful demon's name or the name of one that came from God). Keep in mind they believed that demonic possession caused illness, and so what John noticed was that the two were using Jesus' name because they knew it was so powerful. They were correct, but not for the right reasons. Yes, His name is powerful but that is because He is the Son of God and that they did not know. Therefore, John is upset, but Jesus told John not to be, because whatever is done in His name is doing Jesus' work even if they do not totally understand who Jesus is.

Now we must ask the question, was John worried for Jesus' sake or for his own? Many Scripture commentators believe that John was upset because he, like the others, believed that the use of Jesus' Name should only be limited to them. However, Jesus does tell them that anyone who does a good act and is a person of good will he or she is doing the will of God. God is the creator of us all, and we are made in God's image and likeness, therefore any person can act in His will even those who are not Christians. Remember you cannot spell Good without God.

The same goes for us, we must understand what and why we are doing things in Jesus's name, and we must not be jealous of others who

are using His name. While we may not try to drive out demons in His name, we should be trying to drive out sin and darkness from our lives and the lives of those who Jesus places into our lives-no matter who!

This Thursday October 4th, is the **Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi**, and in honor of this saint who loved animals, we will have our annual blessing of animals at 4:30 PM on the Church Lawn. If it rains, we will move to the Gym.

Please keep in your prayers our young people who are preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on October 20th. Pray for them, their families and their sponsors that they will move closer to God and learn how to use the gifts of the Holy Spirit in concert with Jesus' name.




