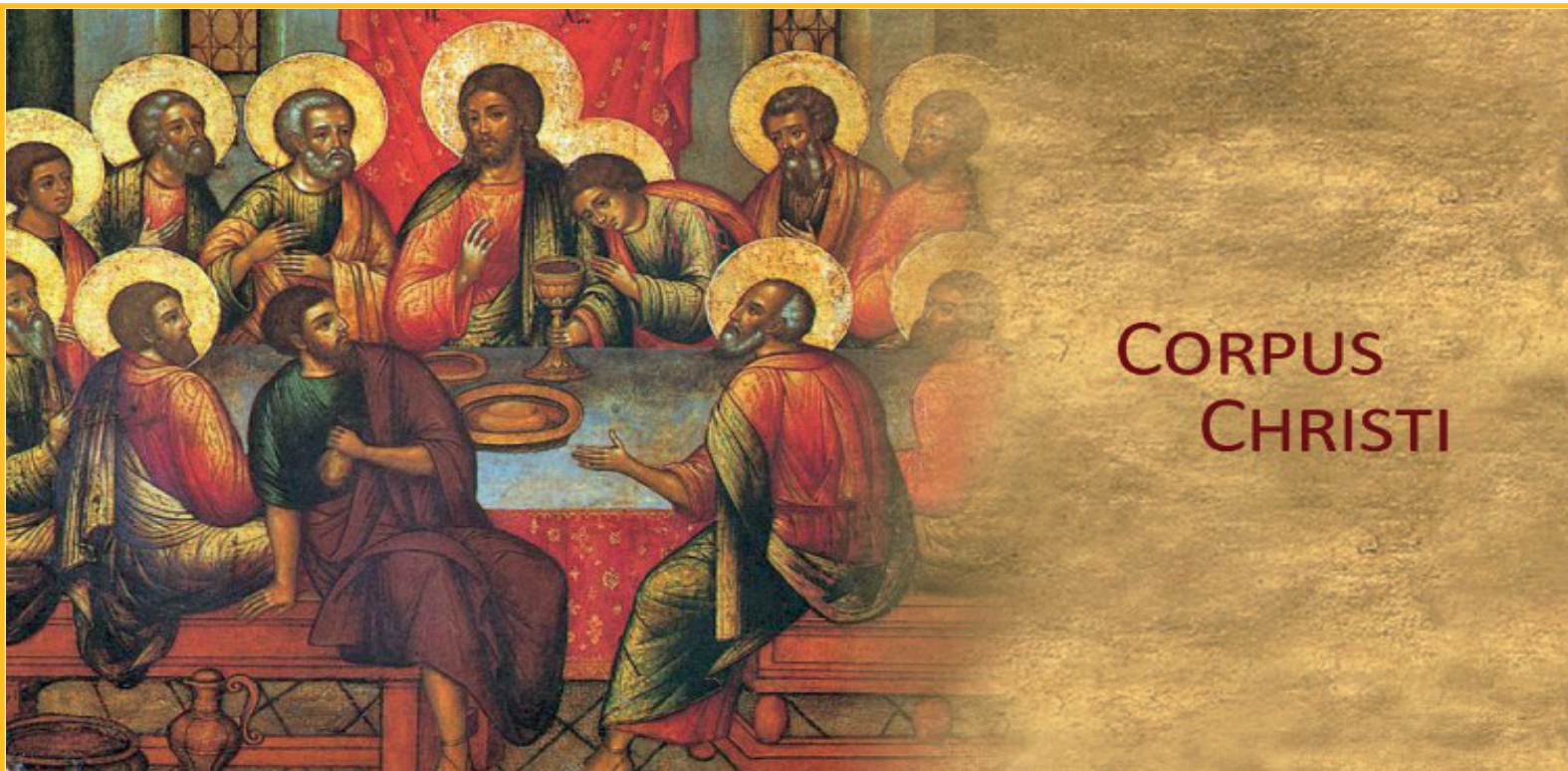

## From Fr. Mike's Desk

*"Jesus said to them, 'Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life...For my flesh is true food and my blood is real drink and who remains in me and I in him...the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever.'"* **Today we celebrate the Great Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ**, in which Saint Paul reminds us that the bread we eat and the cup we drink are more than meets the eye. For in the bread and wine we truly receive Jesus' Body and Blood. This is the real food and drink, which comes down from heaven to make us one with God (through our receiving of the Divine Son) and done with each other (through the power of the Holy Spirit). This heavenly food, unlike what our ancestors ate in the desert, feeds not the body but the soul. This cup of the New Covenant does more than quench our physical thirst; it fills our souls' every desire. This great Sacrament reminds us of the Pascal Sacrifice of Christ on the Cross, which set us free from sin, darkness, and spiritual death, and empowers us to remake the whole world in the image and likeness of Christ.

This great Feast of Corpus Christi also reminds us of the proper way to receive Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. One can receive Communion on the tongue or in the hands. If you are receiving Communion on the tongue, please wait for the minister to say, "The Body of Christ." After your response, "Amen," which means yes, I believe, then please stick out your tongue so the Eucharist can be placed on it. By putting out your tongue, you provide a proper platform to place the Sacred Host. Sometimes people just open their mouths without sticking out their tongues, or they stick their tongue out just a little without opening their mouths. The result is that the Host falls on the floor, or you could pass germs to the minister. During this time of the post-Coronavirus, we must

take extra care not to do this, so please stick out your tongue and open your mouth. Thank you. If you are receiving Communion in the hands, it must be both hands - one which provides the base or the throne to place the King of Kings on, and use the other hand to lift the Blessed Sacrament to your mouth, and then it is received with great reverence and love. Please do not use one hand, and please do not take the Host with just two fingers. This is important because it reminds us of who it is that we are truly receiving in our hearts and souls. Thank you!

## Care for Our Common Home

## The Liturgy Leads Us Back to What is Essential

This week, Pope Leo continued his catechesis series on the Documents of the Second Vatican Council, and reflected on the 1963 Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, *Sacrosanctum Concilium*. *Sacrosanctum Concilium* was the first text to be promulgated at the Second Vatican Council and brought about important changes to the liturgy, such as allowing it to be celebrated in vernacular languages and encouraging a more active participation of the faithful. The pope made three key points:

1. **Do not be silent spectators** - In this regard, the Pope explained that the Council – by building on the Liturgical Movement that pushed for these changes – helped highlight how the rites of the Christian liturgy are not “a mere external covering of the sacramental mystery, a collection of arbitrary ceremonies, but are the ecclesial mediation through which the divine gift reaches us”. Rite gives shape to liturgical action and thus to our lives by “generating in us a spiritual sensibility that makes us capable of savoring the presence of God through Jesus Christ”. However, he noted that this can only happen if we participate actively in the liturgy “with our full selves – body, mind and heart –” and avoid being “strangers or silent spectators.”
2. **The importance of signs and symbols** - Pope Leo explained that “sign” and “symbol” are often used as synonyms but in reality “a sign is symbolic when it is able to refer not only to an idea, but to an entire system of meanings and values.” Symbols, he continued, are instead practical and first and foremost actions “such as kneeling and exchanging the sign of peace” or “the constitutive acts of each Sacrament.”
3. **Reawaken an openness to an encounter with God** - The Pope ended his catechesis by calling all “to allow ourselves to be educated by the rites of the liturgy, caring for the beauty of our celebrations with a delicate touch and without arbitrariness.” “The experience of a living and devout liturgy, accompanied by appropriate mystagogical catechesis, is the best resource for reawakening in everyone that openness to the encounter with God which, in the logic of the Incarnation, can only take place by involving the whole person: spirit, soul, and body,” he concluded.

## Saint Edward's Men's Faith Community

A new **Men's Faith Community** will be starting here at St. Edward's Parish beginning in September.

In a world that often promotes isolation, we can forget that God designed us for community. We are not meant to walk this *'journey of faith'* alone. The bond of Christ-centered brotherhood helps men remain focused on their mission to grow in holiness. It fosters a sense of duty to one another — we are our brother's keeper. We desire the good of our brothers as much as our own, striving to support one another in becoming the husbands, fathers, and saints that God calls us to be. As the center of our bond, Jesus is the unifying source of our strength, purpose, and direction. At each meeting we will listen to one another, question, explore, pray, share our thoughts, and grow in our faith together.

The first meeting will be held on **September 14 at 7:00 PM** on the 3rd floor of St. Edward's School, in both the Chapel and living room. Meetings will continue to be held on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of each month.

**All men of the Parish and the local community are invited to attend.** More details will be provided in future bulletins.

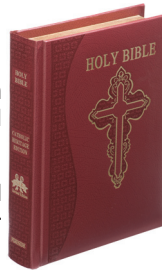


