From Fr. Mike's Desk

The Parables have been spoken, the people with ears have heard and understood them, and Jesus has told us the many things we can compare to the Kingdom of Heaven. Today's Gospel now tells us that Jesus decided to move on so that others could hear the Good News. Yet, as Jesus is moving on, He receives the news that John the Baptist has been executed. When Jesus hears this, He does not take time to mourn or reflect on the life of His cousin; no, He preaches even more fervently. Jesus knows that John's death is a sign that time is likewise short for Him, and He must complete the Public Ministry.

As Jesus preaches, He heals the sick and spends the entire day with the lost sheep of Israel. The Gospel tells us, *"When it was evening, the disciples approached him and said, 'This is a deserted place, and it is already late; dismiss the crowds so that they can go to the villages and buy food for themselves.' Jesus said to them, 'There is no need for them to go away; give them some food yourselves.' But they said to him, 'Five loaves and two fish are all we have!' Then he said, 'Bring them here to me.' Taking the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, he said the blessing, broke the loaves, and gave them to the disciples, who in turn gave them to the crowds. They all ate and were satisfied..."*

Jesus is doing much more than feeding the crowd for just one night. What He is doing is completing His teaching on the Kingdom of Heaven. After speaking about the Kingdom, He is giving them a look at what life will be like in the Kingdom, where there will be no want or hunger. He is giving them a glimpse of the food of heaven, which is not the loaves and fish, but the Body and Blood of Christ. John, in his Gospel, sees this miracle as such a great foreshadowing of the Eucharist that when it comes to his account of the Last Supper, he does not include the Words of Institution because he knows we know them, and he hopes you will see the Eucharist in today's miracle.

The Eucharist is indeed the foretaste of greater things to come. It is the food that helps us avoid sin and spiritual death; it is the food that helps us work for and build the Kingdom of Heaven, and it is Jesus Himself who is feeding us because of His great love for us.

Let us pray: Lord Jesus, you give us your body and blood in the Eucharist as a sign that even now we share your life. May we come to possess it completely in the kingdom where you live forever and ever. Amen.

God bless you always and thank you for supporting St. Edward's and Holy Name of Jesus.

Peter then became afraid of the wind and the waves, and began to sink. Jesus stretched out His hand and saved Peter. Jesus then said to Peter **"...why did you doubt?"**

Jesus says to us **"...do not be afraid."** How often do you start out trusting, only to begin to doubt and flounder?

Lumen Gentium is Latin for "Light of the Nations". It is the name of the Dogmatic Constitution on the Church, which is one of the principal documents of the Second Vatican Council, promulgated by Pope Paul VI on November 21, 1964. The key themes in this document are:

- ◇ **The Church as the "People of God":** It emphasizes that the Church is not just its clergy, but a community of all baptized believers journeying together as a "pilgrim people".
- ◇ **Universal Call to Holiness:** It stresses that all Christians, regardless of their state in life (clergy, religious, or laypeople), are called to strive for spiritual perfection and holiness.
- ◇ **Role of the Laity:** The document redefines the importance of lay Catholics, encouraging their active participation in the Church and recognizing their unique role in the secular world.
- ◇ **Collegiality of Bishops:** It emphasizes the shared responsibility of bishops, working in unity with the Pope, in the governance of the Church.

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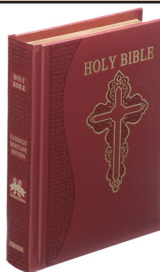


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
