From Fr. Mike's Desk

Today we come to the last day of the Easter Season, the time when Christ completed His part of the Pascal Ministry. Now it is up to us to do our part. Christ is calling us and the whole Church to spread and live out the Gospel. For the last fifty days, we have been reading Gospel Accounts about post-Resurrection appearances and proclamations made by Jesus, and in today's gospel, this continues. We then see in the first and second readings the transition from what the Lord had to say about the ministry now given to the Church by the coming of the Holy Spirit. Our Pentecost readings begin with the account from the Acts of the Apostles, which tells us about the momentous day of the Church's birthday. We read how the Holy Spirit came upon the eleven Apostles, our Dear Blessed Mother, and maybe others who were not mentioned, but were present. Outside the Upper Room, people heard the sound of a great wind and gathered around to see what was happening. What happened then the crowd found unbelievable, but they could not deny what they heard. They heard the Apostles and others gathered, speaking about Jesus in their own language, something the Apostles could not do, but now were indeed doing it.

As we come to Paul's reading, we are told, **"No one** can say 'Jesus is Lord' except by the Holy Spirit," and he tells us about the many gifts given to the Church. In Paul's other reading for today, which is to the Romans, we are told that those who are led by the Spirit of God are indeed Children of God.

As we come to the gospel, we are also given two situations, both found in John's Gospel, but one is from the Last Supper and the other is from Easter Sunday. In the reading from the Last Supper, Jesus tells us not to worry and that He is not going to leave them orphans. He also says, that **"Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him."** This love is not the love most people think of. This love is the love of God, which is unconditional, and it is the kind of love that is demonstrated in obedience. Obedience means hearing, listening to the word, and putting it into action. To do that, we need the power and grace of the Advocate, who is none other than the Holy Spirit. Jesus tells the Apostles in the Upper Room, on the first Easter Sunday Night, to receive the Holy Spirit and adds, **"As the Father has sent me, so I send you,"** and when He says this, He breathed on them and said, **"Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive, are forgiven and whose sins you retain are retained".**

Unless we are open to hearing the Holy Spirit and using the Divine Gifts that the Spirit gives, we cannot totally live in God's love. It is not that God is withholding love or forgiveness; it is that we are not letting it into our hearts and souls.

Today is the Church's Birthday. We are 2,025 years old, so we celebrate by making this wonderful day and time special. Just think, it is the Church's Birthday, but we get all the gifts, and why not, it is our birthday too, because we are the Church.

Happy Pentecost and Happy Easter



Did You Know...?

The Holy Spirit is a divine person, one of the three members of the Holy Trinity (Father, Son and Holy Spirit). The Holy Trinity is three divine persons in one God, with each person wholly possessing the same divine nature – thus their unity.

Each member of the Trinity is a divine spirit, but one member is named the "Holy Spirit," clearly revealed to us by God the Son in the New Testament. Jesus, God the Son who is also known as the Incarnate Word, sent the Holy Spirit on Pentecost (John 16:13 see Acts 2), which is known as the birthday of the Church.

The fruits of the Holy Spirit are: Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. These qualities signify the Holy Spirit's work in a believer's life, marking spiritual growth.

The gifts of the Holy spirit are: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety and Fear of the Lord. These gifts are believed to be infused at Baptism, and strengthened at Confirmation, helping individuals live a holy life.

Prayer: Come, O Spirit of Counsel, help and guide me in all my ways, that I may always do Thy holy will. Incline in my heart to that which is good; turn it away from all that is evil, and direct me by the straight path of Thy commandments to that goal of eternal life for which I long. Amen.
