From Fr. Mike's Desk

How do you settle arguments with others? Do you try to settle them right away, or would you rather hold on to grudges and allow the argument to simmer to a full boil? Jesus is telling us that if we wish to be His follower, we must settle an argument as quickly as possible. Today's gospel gives us the correct way to settle an argument. The **First step** is, *"If your brother sins against you, go tell him his fault between you and him alone."* In addition, *"If he listens to you, you have won over your brother."* If he does not listen, then move on to the **Second step**. Jesus tells us to, *"...take one or two others along with you, so that every fact may be established on the testimony of two or three witnesses."* If your brother refuses to listen, then the **Third step** is to *"tell the Church."* Why must we solve arguments quickly? The answer is, the more we argue, the more that stands in our way of working together to spread the Good News. Nothing should be more important than that!

Notice that the first step is to speak face to face with the person, which requires both parties to be open to settling. We are not to try to hold anything over the other party's head. Jesus is telling us not to go behind the other person's back. We are not to talk about the person with others in an attempt to destroy the other person's reputation or character. Even when we ask for help from another, we are not to do it behind the other party's back. These are indeed good rules to follow, but when is the last time you followed them when you had a major disagreement with another? It is not easy to do, but it is the best thing to do, especially the part of speaking to the person face to face. This usually can help to solve the argument faster. However, even Jesus knows sometimes we can be stubborn, some more than others. Nonetheless, we cannot remain in the same place or allow love to turn into hate, which God certainly does not want. So again, how do we do it? It is simple: we must be open to wanting to settle the problem and not insist on who is wrong or right. As I often tell engaged couples during Pre-Cana Sessions, when it comes to quarreling,

stick to what you are disagreeing about, do not use harsh words or language, and try to listen to each other's point of view. Try to reach a compromise, or even agree to disagree, but never, never try to win! For if either one wins, you both lose!

Remember the words of the Prayer of Saint Francis, *"Make me a channel of your peace, where there is hatred, let me bring your love..."*.

*God bless you always and
may we be instruments of His peace!*

In Matthew's Gospel we hear Jesus teaching Peter about forgiveness. Peter had asked Jesus how many times he should forgive someone, even adding *"As many as seven times?"*. Jesus answered *"...not seven times but seventy-seven times"*.

Jesus didn't speak about which sins or wrongdoing were forgivable, He just says to forgive, and then to forgive again, with no end to the amount of forgiveness to be extended. **Do you sometimes withhold forgiveness based upon your judgement of what was done to you or against you?**

Magnificent Humanity

In his social Encyclical Caritas in Veritate, Pope Benedict XVI sought to reassess and expand the concept of development, interpreting it in light of globalization. He noted that such development should translate into "real growth, of benefit to everyone and genuinely sustainable." He reaffirmed, however, that in wealthy countries new kinds of poverty were emerging as well as unprecedented forms of exclusion, while, in poorer regions, small minorities lived in consumerist affluence alongside situations of dehumanizing poverty. Benedict XVI reiterated that economic activity cannot claim to solve social problems simply through the expansion of a commercial mentality, but must be ordered toward the common good, for which the political community bears its own irreplaceable responsibility.

St. Edward Confessor Religious Education Program is an 8 year faith formation program for children attending public schools or non Catholic private schools. Religious Education Students are required to begin their religious studies in Grade 1 and complete their formal religious education classes in Grade 8.

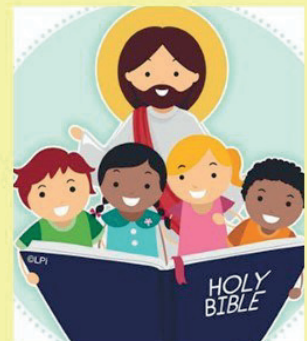
Preparation for their reception of First Confession and First Holy Communion takes place in Grades 1 and 2. Students will receive their First Confession in March of Grade 2 and their First Holy Communion in May of the same year. Grades 3 - 6 are required continuation years for their studies. Confirmation studies occurs in Grades 7 and 8, with their Confirmation reception in the Fall of 9th Grade.

In Person Religion Classes will begin the week of September 27th.

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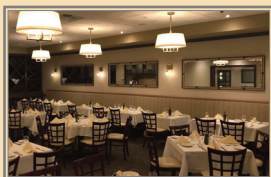

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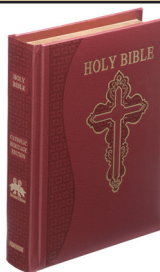


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
