#### From Fr. Mike's Desk

"I have told you this while I am with you. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." These words spoken by Our Lord at the Last Supper tell the Apostles that soon He will be taken away from They, like the words from last week's Gospel, are the final instructions given to them by the earthly Jesus. But they are also words that are meant to reassure them that all will be alright after the events of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday. Last week, Jesus told the Apostles that they should love one another as He had loved them, and this week He tells them how they (and we) can do this. And that is, we will be taught by the Advocate.

The word Advocate is defined as someone who speaks on behalf of another person, especially in a legal context. Implicit in this definition is the idea that the one who is represented lacks the knowledge, skill, ability, or standing to speak for themselves. In our society, many people take on the title of advocate, and this includes various organizations and newspapers. But Jesus is using the word differently from this understanding. Jesus tells us that the Advocate is more than a legal advisor or representative; Jesus is telling us that the Holy Spirit will be like Him. The Holy Spirit will take on the case or the part of the sinner and save him or her from the spiritual danger of losing eternal life. The Holy Spirit will always be present to the Church to defend, guide, and advise every member. The Spirit abides in every believer and the Spirit takes the place of Christ's presence, while at the same time making Christ present, for they are both equally God. The Holy Spirit helps us to love as Jesus commands us to love and helps us make Christ present in all we say and do, so we can continue the work of the Good Shepherd until He comes again!

This Thursday is Ascension Thursday, and it is a holy day of obligation, which means we mark this day by attending the celebration of the Eucharist. Please see in the bulletin the schedule of Masses

for this day. Many think that the Solemnity of the Ascension marks the end of the Jesus story, but it is only the end of one chapter of the Salvation won for us by Christ, and it leads us to the next chapter which has the Holy Spirit as the Advocate, guide, and mover of the Church, the main character.

Let us pray:

Father, at your Son's Ascension into Heaven, you promised to send the Holy Spirit upon your Apostles and your Church. You filled them with heavenly wisdom; fill us with the gifts of the Spirit.
Grant this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, God forever and ever.
