From Fr. Mike's Desk

"You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church." These words from last week's Gospel tell us that Peter is indeed the one to be the chief of the Apostles, and the head of the Church after Our Lord ascended into Heaven. Jesus says at the end of the passage not to tell anyone that He is the Christ. As we continue with Matthew's Gospel, we read, *"Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer greatly from the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised."* Wait, you just told the Apostles that you are the Messiah and that you will be killed. How can this be? This is what Peter is asking himself. Peter cannot bear to hear these words, and since he has been appointed Chief Apostle, he is going to use his new authority. And so, *"...Peter took Jesus aside and began to rebuke him, 'God forbid, Lord! No such thing shall ever happen to you.'"* Now who would blame Peter? Again, this is not supposed to happen to the Savior of the world.

However, Peter at this point forgot one key thing. He is the disciple, Jesus is the master, and of course, as we know, He is God. So, Jesus in a strong voice answers Peter with, ***"Get behind me, Satan. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do."*** Peter and the others did not understand what Jesus said, and they did not understand Him telling them that we all must take up our cross and follow Him. We must seek to lose our lives to this world to gain our lives in the next. So now we see Peter, who was standing above the others, still has his flaws. If you will recall, last week the Prophet Isaiah told us how God appointed Eliakim to be the Master of the Keys, because he would be like a loving father to the people. But as scholars report, in the time that followed, Eliakim falls out of favor because he too abused his power and favored his own household with the people's funds. His flaws also got in the way of his service to God. There is a difference here: Peter, though he is rebuked, is not fired. Instead, he seeks to understand, and our Lord gives him and the other Apostles the time they need. Jesus tells them that they must continue to listen to Him and try to understand.

We must not think as human beings do; we must try to think like God. And how do we do this since we are not God? We cannot cry out as Jeremiah does in the first reading, *"You duped me, O Lord, and I let myself be duped."* We cannot believe that God has forced us, with His call for us to follow Him and think like Him.

God did not dupe Jeremiah; He did not dupe Peter and the others, and He does not dupe us. How then can we understand or even think like God? While it is true that we will never fully understand God, even when we see God face to face, it is also true that we know what God wants and how we are to live. How do we know? That is not so hard; all we have to do is see God working in the Old Testament and hear the word of God in the Gospel. **For Jesus, the Word of God**, is telling us directly how God thinks, as He tells us He and the Father are one.

Now we know we all have flaws; we all do things we know we should not do, and we know we do not always put our best foot forward. We are just like Peter, but just like Peter, we cannot let our flaws get in the way of our serving God and making our way toward Heaven.

Registration Info for the 2026-2027 School Year



St. Edward Confessor Religious Education Program is an 8 year faith formation program for children attending public schools or non Catholic private schools. Religious Education Students are required to begin their religious studies in Grade 1 and complete their formal religious education classes in Grade 8.

Preparation for their reception of First Confession and First Holy Communion takes place in Grades 1 and 2. Students will receive their First Confession in March of Grade 2 and their First Holy Communion in May of the same year. Grades 3 - 6 are required continuation years for their studies. Confirmation studies occurs in Grades 7 and 8, with their Confirmation reception in the Fall of 9th Grade.

In Person Religion Classes will begin the week of September 27th.

Families whose children were enrolled in SEC Religious Education Classes last year should have received the latest Registration Email on July 27th. If you have not yet registered and have not received any re-registration emails, please contact Mrs. Braun at 516-921-8543 x 124 or by emailing her at abraun@st-edwards.org

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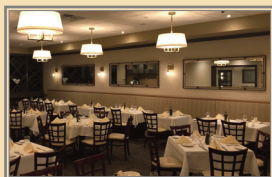
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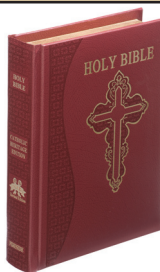


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
