#### From Fr. Mike's Desk

School has been in session for a few weeks, and I know that our students are just settling into a new year. When I was in school, I used to like how school started slowly, and we did not have everything thrown at us at once. This seemed to change as I got older and went through each grade. Before you knew it, on the first day, you realized you were already behind a week, and that was especially true in college and graduate school.

Today, Jesus is giving us a crash course on the Gospels, and He does this through the many lessons in Luke's Gospels. According to William Barclay, a world-renowned Scripture Scholar, he tells us that Christ is giving us four lessons in one Gospel, so pay attention! The first lesson is that people of this world are wiser in their own generation, more so than the children of the light. As he writes, "...if only the Christian were as eager and ingenious in his attempt to obtain goodness as the man of the world looks to obtain money." Jesus is telling us our Christianity will be truly effective when we spend as much time and effort on it as we do on worldly activities.

The next lesson involves wealth itself. Barclay believes that having wealth itself is not a terrible thing; it is what you do with it. If all we do is just concentrate on accruing wealth, it consumes us. If we use wealth to cement the friendships we were in, then it cannot be used to help the poor, to make life easier for those in need. We must look at the idea that having wealth is not a sin, but it carries with it great responsibility, and the person who uses wealth has a great task.

The next lesson Jesus gives us concerns the way one conducts a small task (which shows how he/she will conduct a larger one. As Barclay tells us, no person will advance to a higher office until he/she gives proof of honesty and ability. Your gifts and talents are only given to you for a fleeting time, but how you use them shows us how we get to eternal life.

When it comes to service to God, we must look at ourselves not as a steward, but as a slave when it comes to God. As a slave, we cannot serve two masters, but only one God. Keep in mind, a slave has no spare time, since every moment of his day is given to and belongs to God. Serving God can never be considered a part-time job. God must be looked at as our exclusive master, and we should look at ourselves and all we are and be firm that we belong to God totally or not at all.

One does not know if the Unjust Steward realized that part with his new master, but Jesus is telling us that we should be that way with God.

Welcome back to school!





St. Edward's Religious Education Program is an 8 year faith formation program for children attending public schools or non Catholic private schools. Religious Education Students are required to begin their religious studies in Grade 1 and complete their formal religious education classes in Grade 8.

Preparation for their reception of First Confession and First Holy Communion takes place in Grades 1 and 2. Students will receive

their First Confession in March of Grade 2 and their First Holy Communion in May of same year. Grades 3 - 6 are required continuation years for their studies. Confirmation studies occurs in Grades 7 and 8, with their Confirmation in the Fall of 9th Grade.


