# The Baptism of the Lord

## Reading 1 - Isaiah 42:1-4, 6-7

Thus says the LORD:

Here is my servant whom I uphold,

Peter proceeded to speak to those gathered in the house of Cornelius, saying: "In truth, I see that God shows no partiality. Rather, in every nation whoever fears him and acts uprightly is acceptable to him. You know the word that he sent to the Israelites as he proclaimed peace through Jesus Christ, who is Lord of all, what has happened all over Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached, how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power. He went about doing good and healing all those oppressed by the devil, for God was with him."

## Gospel – Luke 3:15-16, 21-22

The people were filled with expectation, and all were asking in their hearts whether John might be the Christ. John answered them all, saying, "I am baptizing you with water, but one mightier than I is coming. I am not worthy to loosen the thongs of his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire."

After all the people had been baptized and Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."

## From Fr. Mike's Desk

In five months from now, we will be celebrating the joyful occasion of First Communions. Over a period of three Saturdays, we will be helping our young people and their families to come closer and closer to Christ, as they receive Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament for the first time. During the celebration, I usually tell the first communicants that this is the third most important day in their lives! I then ask them if they know the most important day of their lives. Some answer right away and some say Baptism is the most important day. Of course, I must tell them that they are wrong, and they look at me with great surprise, especially since one of their parents gave them that answer. Then I tell them that the first most important day was the day they were born, without that day nothing else could happen. Then I proceed to speak about the second day, and of course, it is Baptism. Baptism, the day we are born again in the Spirit. In John's Gospel, Jesus tells Nicodemus that a person cannot be saved unless they are born again in the Spirit. However, this holy man does not understand what Jesus is saying. He then asks Jesus, how can a person once born, re-enter their mother's womb. To this Jesus says, what is flesh is flesh, and that which is Spirit is Spirit. In the waters of Baptism, our human flesh takes on a new relationship with God as we become living temples of the Holy Spirit. In Baptism, the Holy Spirit comes into our souls and dwells within us and conforms us to become more like Christ, as we are set free from being slaves to sin. Baptism is more than an event which happens at a person's birth, it is an event which changes and forms us throughout our whole life, and it guides us to the Kingdom of God.

Baptism is prefigured in the baptism that John was doing at the Jordan River. John was calling people to repentance and basically asking them to make a pledge to be ready when the Messiah comes. It was a great surprise to John when Jesus comes to him to be baptized, and why does He who is without sin come to John to be baptized? There are many answers to this, but the one that is central for me is the idea that the Messiah wants to be one with the people He has come to save (which of course, is all humanity). By joining them, by joining us, Christ is establishing solidarity, and is calling us to follow Him. Remember it was John the Baptist who would point Him out to His first disciples after Jesus came out of the desert. This feast day reminds us

that the Messiah who is born unto us as a babe in Bethlehem, is not pretending to be one of us, He really is one of us. As we celebrated on December 25<sup>th</sup>, God has become one of us, to save us, to restore us, and to change the world and build the kingdom of God.

In the reading from the Acts of the Apostles (one of the options for today) Peter is drawn to the house of Cornelius, who is a Roman. Cornelius wishes to be baptized with his whole family, even though many of Jesus' followers resist the idea because he is not a Jew. However, Peter does not let that stop him, after the vision Peter received from God earlier. Peter proceeds to say, "...I see that God shows no partiality. Rather, in every nation whoever fears Him, and acts uprightly is acceptable to Him." God does not care what country we come from, God does not care what race or ethnic group we belong to or what language we speak, nor does God care if we are male or female; we have all been called. God loves us all; this is truly the message of Christmas and Easter.



## New York State - Important Update to Mask Mandate

Dear Brothers:

The New York State website FAQ's that accompany the **Governor's directives regarding masks now includes "houses of worship"**.

Therefore, since Churches will **not** be requiring parishioners to present proof of vaccination, we ask that the following announcement be clearly communicated to parishioners through your normal means of communication:

**"The Governor of New York State has included houses of worship in her recent directives. Therefore, since the Church does not require parishioners to present proof of vaccination in order to worship God, we ask that all parishioners (two years of age and older) comply with the requirement to wear masks when participating in any activities on parish grounds. This State requirement is currently in effect through January 15, 2022. We will continue to adapt accordingly as new information becomes available. Your patience and Christian charity towards one another during this difficult time is appreciated."**

For your information: Priests and any other clergy / assistants may wear masks while processing in / out and while distributing Holy Communion. Please encourage all parishioners, especially volunteers / ushers, to be patient and charitable towards all. It is **not** the responsibility of any individual to police / enforce State regulations. 


