From Fr. Mike's Desk

After his election in October of 1958, Pope John XXIII (now Pope Saint John XXIII), wanted to visit the inmates at Rome's Regina Caeli Prison. This desire of the new pope did not come to fulfillment until December of that year, when he made a Christmas visit. When the Pope arrived at the prison, he told the prisoners that he came as: "Joseph your brother." He shared with them that since they could not come to him, he had to come to them. He also told them not to give up hope, and know that they could change their lives after they served their terms. He told them this as he shared with them that he had relatives who had served time and they came out with no lasting harm. Saint John told the gathered group that he wanted to see the world through their eyes. He truly won over their hearts; in fact, one person came to him, a murderer, fell on his knees and asked the Pope, "Holy Father, can there be forgiveness for the likes of me?" The Pope simply stood him up, and embraced him as a sign for all to see and said, yes God can and does forgive even murder. All one needs is a desire to receive and be open to the forgiveness that God offers. All were impressed by this visit, not just because he was the Pope, and he came to see them, but because he took the time to minister to them and to share their existence; if only for a while.

Today that is what we remember on the part of Jesus, who comes to the Jordon to be baptized by John alongside them who were seeking repentance and to come closer to God. If only those who were on the riverbank that day knew how close they were to the presence of God! Our Lord shared with those their existence as He too was baptized even though He was without sin. In short, He did not need baptism because of sin, He chose to do so that we could freely identify with Him and He could identify with us. This, of course, is the whole mystery of the Incarnation, for God truly has become one of us in the person of Jesus. Saint John XXIII, like his Holy Master, did the same; he shared the prisoners' existence, so that they could feel the love and presence of God through His Servant, the successor of St. Peter, who is Christ's Vicar on Earth. Just as Jesus did 2020 years ago, so He does now for us and with us as He continues to share our lives and, through His great gift, allows us to share His life. Through this gift, we are freed from sin and darkness. This is what we celebrate on this special Feast Day. Today we celebrate the Lord's solidarity with us through His

baptism by John. Let us recall our entering more closely with Jesus, the Father, and the Holy Spirit as we remember our Baptismal Promises, for each say 'I Do' (even if it is only to yourself).

Do you reject Satan? And all of his works?

And all of his empty promises?

Do you believe in God the Father almighty, creator of Heaven and Earth? Do you believe in Jesus Christ His only Son, Our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary, was crucified, died and was buried, rose from the dead, and is now seated at the right hand of the Father? Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic

Church, the Communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting?

This is our faith. This is the faith of the Church. We are proud to profess it, in Christ Jesus our Lord. Amen.

And for the last time this year, Merry Christmas!

Did Your Life Change?

During his Angelus last week following the Mass for the Solemnity of the Epiphany Pope Francis drew his inspiration from the day's Gospel and spoke of the Magi. The Pontiff described how after encountering the baby Jesus, their lives were changed. saw a different king, a king "who is not of this world", meek and humble, yet indicated in agreement by the stars and the Holy Scriptures." The Pope went on to explain that "the encounter with Jesus does not hold back the Magi, on the contrary, it gives them a new impetus to return to their country, to tell what they saw and the joy they felt." The experience of knowing God, remarked Pope Francis, "does not block us, but frees us; it does not imprison us, but it puts us back on the road...". The Gospel passage, he emphasized, "contains a detail which prompts our reflection. At the end of the story, it is said that the Magi were "warned in a dream not to return to Herod, and by another route they returned to their country"".

Every experience of meeting Jesus, noted the Pope, "leads us to take different paths, because from Him comes a good force that heals the heart and detaches us from evil."

"This is the difference between the true God and traitorous idols, such as money, power, success...; between God and those who promise to give you these idols, such as magicians, fortune tellers, and sorcerers," he said.






