Christian Beatitude

God puts us in the world to know, to love, and to serve Him, and so to come to paradise. Beatitudes make us “partakers of the divine nature” and of eternal life. With beatitude, man enters into the glory of Christ and into the joy of the Trinitarian life.

Catechism of the Catholic Church - 1721

From Fr. Mike's Desk

“When Jesus heard that John had been arrested, he withdrew to Galilee. He left Nazareth and went to live in Capernaum by the sea, in the region of Zebulun and Naphtali...Galilee of the Gentiles, the people who sit in darkness have seen a great light... From that time on, Jesus began to preach and say, ‘Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.’” Matthew tells us in today's Gospel that Jesus upon hearing of John's arrest takes this as a signal to begin His public ministry. Today's reading tells us, that He does not begin in His hometown, but in a part of Galilee that has more gentiles than Jews, more pagans than believers. This is a fulfillment of the words of Isaiah seen in today's first reading, as we see God preaching the Good News to the people who were living in darkness. Jesus tells them to repent for the kingdom of heaven is near. We are led to believe that many people both Jews and gentiles listened to Him. This could be, as we saw in last's week's gospel, because John pointed Him out as the Lamb of God, and he told them that Jesus was the one they were waiting for. It could also be, that Jesus, the Son of God, knew how to speak to them directly, to their hearts, just as He does today! Of course, they had to be open to what He had to say, and they had to freely accept it, because God will never force Himself on us. Jesus goes not only to the lost sheep, of Israel but to all people in all places.

However, to keep the message alive for all, Jesus calls the first disciples: Simon Peter, Andrew, James, and John. He tells them to follow Him, and they will become fishers of men. They left everything behind and became not just His disciples, but His Apostles (one who is especially sent). It is upon these four and the eight who would follow along, that Jesus builds the foundation of the Church. It is on the foundation of the 12 (representing the restoration of the Twelve Tribes of ancient Israel and the fulfillment of all prophecy) that the Good News is entrusted. It is on the foundation of the twelve and their descendants, the Pope and Bishops, of the Church, that the Good News is always preached, people are continually healed, and the Spirit is and always will be felt. This is truly the job for the Pope, Bishops, Priests, Deacons, Religious Women and Men, and one other group. You! Yes, you because it is every Christians job to be a disciple. It is up to us to use the gifts that God has given us and go out and work. We are not to do this by ourselves, but with each other, that is why Jesus in the Gospel sent the apostles out two by

two, so one could back up the other.

This month, we will celebrate *Catholic Schools' Month*, and it promises to be a great month. We will have *Open House* hours where you can come, tour the school, and see all the good things that *St. Edward's School* has to offer your children, grandchildren, cousins, and neighbor's kids. During this month, you can meet with our principal *Mr. Vincent Albrecht*, and many of our teachers. A Catholic Education provides your child with all they need to know about this world, and with all they need to know about the world to come. It provides them with all the tools they need to change the world, and to do their part in building up the church and the Kingdom of God. **Please feel free to call the school at (516) 921-7767; you will be happy you did.**




