# From Fr. Mike's Desk

"Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace, according to your word, for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in the sight of all the people: a light of revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of your people Israel."

These words spoken by Simeon are his acknowledgement of the gift that God, the Holy Spirit, revealed to him; that he would not die until he saw the Messiah. Today reminds us of the fulfillment of all of God's promises. The Feast of The Presentation of the Lord, is a major feast day and so today it takes the place of a Sunday Mass in Ordinary Time. We are now in the fourth week of Ordinary Time. we have left Christmas behind at least four weeks ago, and yet we are coming back, if not to Christmas, at least to the infancy of As the Gospel begins, "When the Jesus. for davs completed were purification...Mary and Joseph took Jesus up to Jerusalem to present him to the *Lord*..." They were fulfilling the Law of Moses, as Jesus was the first-born male, and according to the Law He had to be redeemed. This law refers to the Passover and because the first born of Jews were spared, the first-born male had to be redeemed by a sacrifice offered up to God.

As we look at this Feast Day and last week's readings, we see that both passages are related, even though the Presentation occurred thirty years earlier. Last week Jesus called His disciples to be fishers of men, and that they will reflect the light of Christ, which will dispel the darkness. Today's readings tell us that the actual Light has come into His own house. For God, in the person of Jesus, has come to the Temple and all prophecy will be fulfilled. This event also serves as a foreshadowing of the other visits Jesus will

make to the Temple (such as the Finding in the Temple, or the times Jesus went to the Temple in John's Gospel and of course the last time, when He overturns the moneychangers tables).

So let us take this time to return to the Christmas Season or at least at a time when things seemed easier for the Holy Family. Let's also keep in mind that this visit of the Messiah to the Temple does more than just fulfill the Law of Moses. This visit reminds us that the Messiah's Mission has begun as Old and New Testaments come together. Perhaps it calls us to think about re-presenting ourselves to the Father, and to seek the Grace of the Holy Spirit, so that we can become better disciples of Jesus.

While today gives us a good look back, remember that the Holy Season of Lent is only about a month away (with the first Sunday of Lent occurring on March 1).

Happy Feast of the Presentation, Happy Ordinary Time and let us look forward to a very good Season of Lent as we try to re-present ourselves to the Lord.




