From Fr. Mike's Desk

There is an idiom that suggests that sometimes it is an advantage not to know something or the facts behind an event! This idiom is, "Ignorance is Bliss." It is a commonly used expression, and sometimes it seems true.

However, there are times when ignorance is not bliss and not knowing something can lead you into harm. Our reading from the Acts of the Apostles points this out as St. Peter speaks to the people of Jerusalem. Peter traces salvation history and tells them that the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob glorified his servant Jesus. The promised Messiah was here, and you handed Him over to Pilate and denied Him. Even when Pilate tried to free Him, you called for Barabas instead of Jesus. Thus, you participated in putting the author of life to death.


But God raised Him from the dead, and Peter and the Apostles are witnesses. Peter then tells them that they acted out of ignorance, just as their leaders did. However, through Jesus God has brought to fulfillment what was announced to the people beforehand, through the prophets. Yes, the Christ had to suffer, so that our sins could be washed away. Peter is calling the people to follow the Apostles and become one with Christ through Baptism. He calls them to live in ignorance no longer, for there is no bliss in it.

Before we look unfavorably upon the people of Jerusalem and the leaders, we must also keep in mind that the Apostles behaved the same way, from Holy Thursday to Easter Sunday. They too were caught up in ignorance as they ran away in fright and even denied Jesus three times. Even when they encountered the Risen Lord they did not fully understand, and Thomas even went to the point of not believing until he could see it with his own eyes. The men on the road to Emmaus did not understand when the stranger appeared on the road and told them what Scripture was all about when it came to the Messiah. We also see their partial ignorance when Jesus appears to them on Easter Night. Jesus asked them, why were they frightened, and He breathed upon them and told them "*Peace be with you.*" Their fear was transformed into incredulous joy. Before He left them that night, He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. No longer to walk in darkness and ignorance but in the light and life of the resurrection of Christ. As the Apostles left ignorance, so shall we when it comes to spreading the Good News and living out the Gospel.

Ignorance has no place where faith should be found, because if it is, we are not living in bliss. Even if we do not understand Jesus is always here and is always forgiving us of our sins.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

We know that the challenges of an unplanned pregnancy can seem insurmountable. This is especially true when it feels like there is no support for a pregnant woman struggling to appreciate the precious gift of life she carries and may compel her towards a regrettable decision. But genuine empowerment of women comes only through recognizing the dignity of the human person at every stage of life and this is most poignantly illuminated through the blessings of motherhood.

In this, it is with great joy that I announce the **FIAT Pregnancy Support Program** at Catholic Health. This program, in partnership with the Diocese of Rockville Centre, comprises a dedicated help line designed to assist women access the **counsel, resources, and encouragement needed to choose life** when facing a pregnancy with unexpected or difficult circumstances. **The Pregnancy Support Team is available 24x7, 365 days of the year** to assist callers in accessing the services needed to help them see that every new life is a blessing, even when there are challenges.

Any expectant woman in need of help can call the FIAT Pregnancy Support Program and be confident that, **regardless of age, religion, immigration status or ability to pay**, she will receive compassionate, non-judgmental, and *life-affirming* care. Most of all, she can be assured that she will not be alone through her pregnancy, and she will not be abandoned after she delivers her child. If she is overwhelmed by an unexpected pregnancy, contemplating abortion pills on her college campus, distressed with an adverse prenatal diagnosis, experiencing a miscarriage, worried about feeding her child, regretting a past abortion or other pregnancy-related distress, FIAT is there to help her sort things out and get the care she needs. It only takes the courage of a phone call to find real hope: **631-476-LOVE (5683)**.

It is my prayer that the **FIAT Pregnancy Support Program** be recognized across the Diocese of Rockville Centre as the first step a woman takes when facing challenging circumstances during pregnancy. There are promotional materials available at every parish and on-line, but we ask for your help to make this resource known widely through your prayers, your witness, and your word-of-mouth, for every one of us has an important and serious responsibility to spread the Gospel of Life. Let FIAT lead the way.


