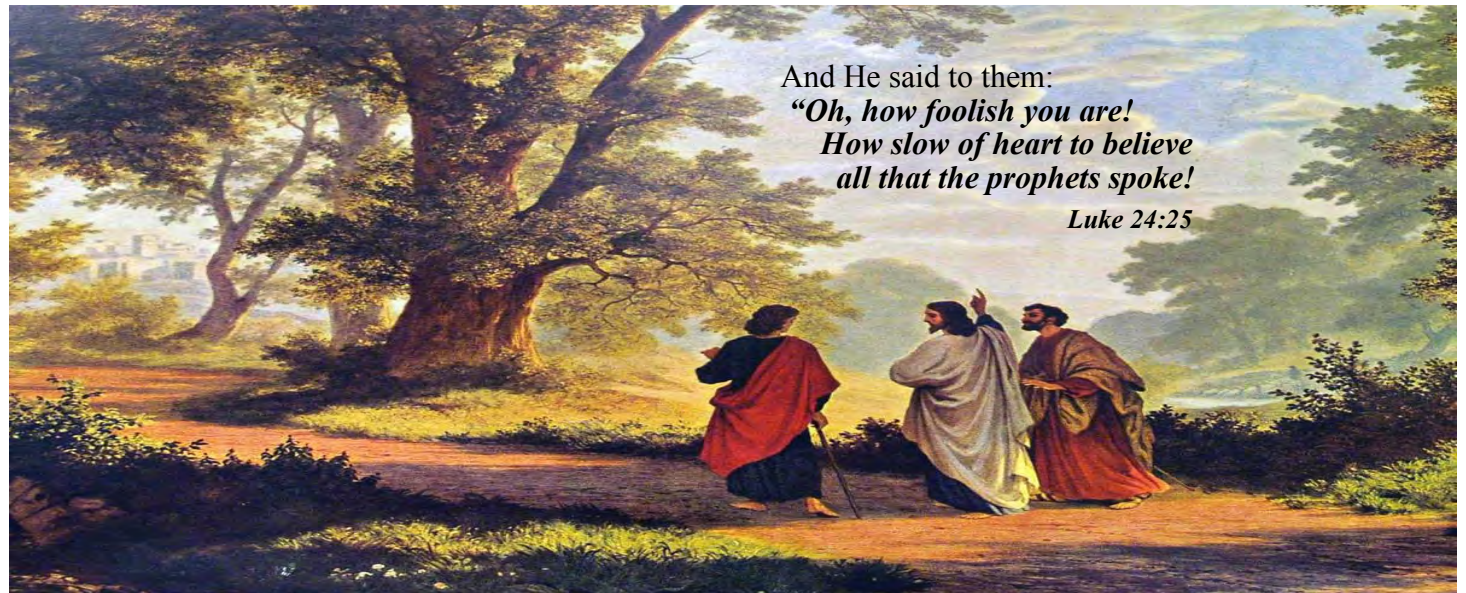

From Fr. Mike's Desk

Last weekend we read from John's Gospel of the account of the events that occurred on the first Easter Sunday night. How on that night, Jesus appeared to the Apostles and those who were gathered in the upper room. During His appearance, He told them to receive the Holy Spirit, and that as the Father has sent Him, so now He is sending them. All are present except Thomas, and when Thomas returns, he is told about Jesus' visit, but he refuses to believe. That following week Jesus appeared again, and this time Thomas was present, and when he saw Jesus he fell on the ground and made the most profound statement of faith as he proclaimed, ***"My Lord and my God!"***

This week's Gospel from Luke gives us another account of a post-resurrection appearance. Today we listen to the events that occurred on *the Road to Emmaus*. Like Thomas, the two disciples did not believe. They heard the report that the women who went to the tomb made. They reported that they saw a vision of angels who told them that Jesus had risen. The women found the tomb empty, but Jesus was nowhere in sight. So, on that Sunday afternoon the two disciples, totally dismayed, took a long walk. They just could not believe what had happened over the past three days, and they could not cope. So, they took a walk and they talked about the events. They were so upset they do not even notice the stranger who came up behind them. The man asked what they were talking about and the two turned around and looked at him like he had two heads. *"Are you the only visitor to Jerusalem who does not know of the things that have taken place?"* Their answer to Jesus was very forceful and likewise filled with sadness. It was at his point that Our Lord gave them an answer they could not refute. As Luke tells us, He interpreted all the Scriptures that dealt with the Messiah from Moses to the Prophets. He pointed out to them that the Messiah had to suffer all these things so we could be saved.

They were just like Thomas, they refused to believe the accounts of the Resurrection. They refused to believe, although many Scripture commentators believe that they truly did want to believe. One such commentator is no less than Pope St. John Paul II. Why do the commentators believe this? It can be seen with the words they utter at the end of the account. *"Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us..."*

They changed their minds most certainly when Jesus broke the bread and vanished before their sight as they recognized Him. Last week Jesus told Thomas that he believed because he had seen, but blessed are those who believe without seeing.

The experience of the two on the Road to Emmaus should help us to believe that Jesus is always present to us. He will help us get through every crisis of faith, and He will indeed set our hearts on fire. They recognized Jesus in the breaking of the bread, as we will in the Sacrifice of the Mass. However, we can and should see Jesus in each other, even ourselves.

Fr. Mike's Letter for Week 5 of the Corona Virus Crisis

The following letter was posted on the St. Edward's website as well as on Flocknote prior to Divine Mercy Sunday. The letter is reprinted here for those of you who do not have internet access.

This Sunday the Church not only celebrates the Octave of Easter, with the Second Sunday of Easter, but also, we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. As you know, this day was instituted by His Holiness Pope St. John Paul II, on the same day he declared Saint Faustina a saint of the Church. Jesus, the Divine Mercy, appeared to the Polish nun and asked her to help people know of Jesus' great love and mercy for humanity. He told her to tell people that they should trust in Him always, that He would never withhold His love, mercy, and forgiveness. Our Lord directed that an icon be created, showing His great love and on the icon should be the words, "**Jesus, I Trust in You.**" Jesus the Divine Mercy is the one we should be focusing on during this crisis time of pandemic. We keep hearing that we are at the apex (at least for New York) or we reached a plateau, and yet the death rate seems to climb. We keep hearing of new cases being added and so we ask where is the progress? And sadly, we hear about loved ones and friends dying and wonder why and what can be done!

In one way we are doing what we can by enduring this lockdown, and hopefully slowing the spread of the virus. We do this at the great sacrifice of our normal lives and activities, and by not attending Mass so others may live. The other way we can help is given to us by this great day. The Gospel tells us how Thomas doubted that Jesus had indeed risen from the dead and appeared to the Apostles that first Easter Sunday Night. His doubt is so famous, or infamous, that it earned him the name Doubting Thomas. In this time of doubt, we should not behave like Thomas, but we should turn to Jesus with our prayers and trust and know that Jesus is always here. Even when times seem dark, Christ is still our light that shines through. As Saint Faustina, Saint John Paul II and Our Lord tell us, never stop trusting in Jesus.

Again, thank you for your continued prayers and support, and know that you are always in my prayers and those of Fr. Hyacinth, Deacon Jim, and Deacon Barry. Thank you for your continued support of the Food Pantry. We are in constant need of food, household items, diapers, etc. If you can help, please do. You can leave food and items in the brown wooden box in the Church lobby. Keep in mind that we are helping more people than usual as so many people have lost their jobs. Again, thank you for your wonderful generosity.

Remember, we will get through this together and with the help of God.

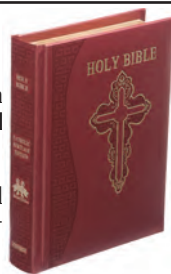
