

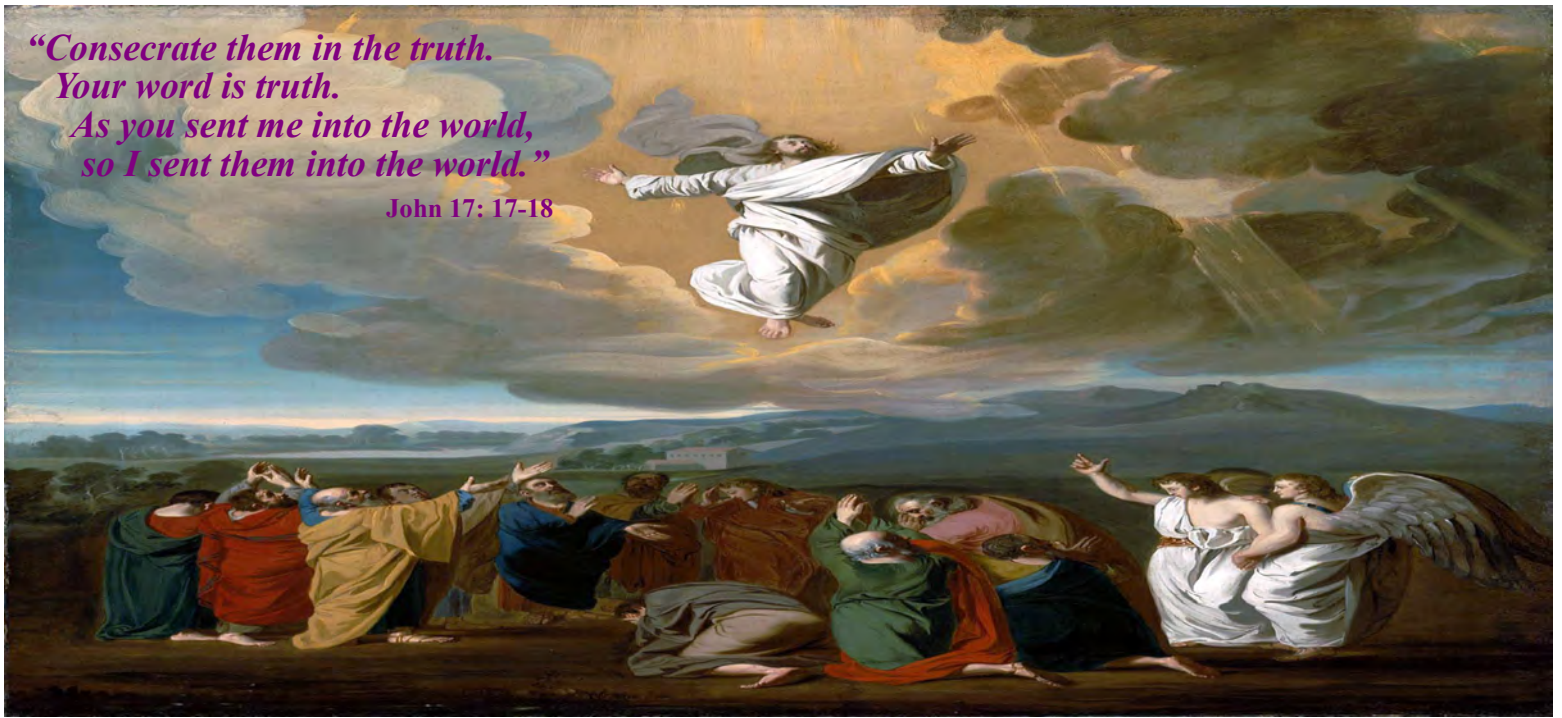

The Readings for the Seventh Sunday of Easter

Reading 1 - Acts 1:15-17, 20a, 20c-26

Peter stood up in the midst of the brothers — there was a group of about one hundred and twenty persons in the one place —. He said, “My brothers, the Scripture had to be fulfilled which the Holy Spirit spoke beforehand through the mouth of David, concerning Judas, who was the guide for those who arrested Jesus. He was numbered among us and was allotted a share in this ministry.

“For it is written in the Book of Psalms:

May another take his office.

“Therefore, it is necessary that one of the men who accompanied us the whole time the Lord Jesus came and went among us, beginning from the baptism of John until the day on which he was taken up from us, become with us a witness to his resurrection.” So they proposed two, Judas called Barsabbas, who was also known as Justus, and Matthias. Then they prayed, “You, Lord, who know the hearts of all, show which one of these two you have chosen to take the place in this apostolic ministry from which Judas turned away to go to his own place.” Then they gave lots to them, and the lot fell upon Matthias, and he was counted with the eleven apostles.

Reading 2 – 1 John 4:11-16

Beloved, if God so loved us, we also must love one another. No one has ever seen God. Yet, if we love one another, God remains in us, and his love is brought to perfection in us.

This is how we know that we remain in him and he in us, that he has given us of his Spirit. Moreover, we have seen and testify that the Father sent his Son as savior of the world. Whoever acknowledges that Jesus is the Son of God, God remains in him and he in God. We have come to know and to believe in the love God has for us. God is love, and whoever remains in love remains in God and God in him.

Gospel – John 17:11b-19

Lifting up his eyes to heaven, Jesus prayed saying:

“Holy Father, keep them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one just as we are one. When I was with them I protected them in your name that you gave me, and I guarded them, and none of them was lost except the son of destruction, in order that the Scripture might be fulfilled. But now I am coming to you. I speak this in the world so that they may share my joy completely. I gave them your word, and the world hated them, because they do not belong to the world any more than I belong to the world. I do not ask that you take them out of the world but that you keep them from the evil one. They do not belong to the world any more than I belong to the world. Consecrate them in the truth. Your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, so I sent them into the world. And I consecrate myself for them, so that they also may be consecrated in truth.”

Prayer to St. Michael

St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle, be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him we humbly pray; and do thou, O Prince of the Heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

From Fr. Mike's Desk

Today we find Jesus praying to the Father as He asks God to consecrate the Apostles in truth and to protect them from the world. In fact, in other verses of this chapter, Jesus tells the Father that He is not praying for the world, only for His Apostles. The reason for this is Jesus tells them that they are like Him, and they no longer belong to the world, but we should also note that Jesus does not ask the Father to take the Apostles out of the world.

This prayer for the Apostles is also the Son's prayer for His living Body, the Church. We, like the Apostles, are to remain in the world, but we must remember that we are not part of the world. We, like the Apostles and Jesus, are in the world so that we can change the world. The meaning of the world in this prayer and passage does not mean living on the earth. The world means in the ancient Jewish tradition anything that is hostile to God, or under the power of Satan. We are in a battle that we must fight constantly, as we go against the powers of darkness and death. The tools and weapons that we use in this battle are the instruments of light and life. They are the Words of Jesus, the Sacraments of the Church, and the gifts given to each of us by God the Holy Spirit. If you do not believe that we are in this battle, just look at how the Church and Christians are abused and even murdered in some countries, in the media, and even from the state.

Now if the world hates us, why should we try to change it? Well, for the very reason why Christ came into the world and that reason is Love! The love that John tells us about in his letter, especially when he tells us that God is love. If God is love (and He is), so must we love, and when we do, God remains in us and His love is brought to perfection within us. We cannot truly say that we love Jesus and acknowledge Him as our Savior unless we love others and do our best to fight the power of sin and darkness and spread the Good News.

Next Sunday May 23rd, we celebrate the Great Feast of Pentecost, the Birthday of the Church and the last day of the Easter Season. As we will see next week, this is the day the Father and the Son sent the Holy Spirit upon the Church and empowered the Apostles to preach the Gospel, and build the Church in every part of the globe. Since this is the Feast Day of the Holy Spirit, the color of the day is RED, representing the fire, love, and power of the Holy Spirit. Maybe you might want to consider wearing Red next weekend; I will be!

Fr. Mike's Letter for Week 60 of the Corona Virus Crisis

The following letter was posted last week, prior to the Sixth Sunday of Easter, on the St. Edward's website as well as on Flocknote.

So how are you doing? I asked you this question about a year ago when we first entered this COVID-19 world. How are you holding on? Hopefully for all of us, we are doing better than the last time I asked you! I do know that for some of us, fear of the virus is still a reality, and it should be. I also know that some of us are not coming out unless we have to, and I do understand these feelings especially if we have underlying conditions. There is no need to take unnecessary chances, but do keep in mind the news, at least now, is a little better. I am happy to say that the numbers at Sunday Mass have gone up a little, and I can not wait for the day when we do not have to block off rows.

We have been successful in upgrading the Church's sound system and having the camera installed in the Church. We are now able to put on the internet our 7:30 AM and 11:30 AM Masses, and many are watching. As wonderful as that is, it is different from coming to Mass in person. It is not the same as being able to receive Jesus in the Eucharist. And it is different from celebrating and sharing our faith with our parish family. Of course, you must do what you think is best for your situation, and we totally understand that, but if things are better for you, maybe you can add coming to Mass as a part of your life. The Church is properly laid out so social distancing can be maintained and wearing of masks is still required. I believe that the Church is a very safe place to go during this difficult time. Also, if you cannot come out on Sunday keep in mind that we celebrate Mass Monday to Saturday at 9 AM.

I miss seeing so many of you and I want to see you again. Please know that you are always in my prayers and know that we are always here if you need us. I also want to thank you for your continued support. Without you we are not able to continue. However, I am not happy to report, that our Sunday Collections are very low at this time, and soon we might be getting into a position where we cannot make ends meet. If you can help us a little more, that would go a long way in helping Saint Edward's carry out its part of the Divine Mission. I know that we can count on you, because you are always so generous and help the Church when you can. And as always, if you cannot give a little more, we completely understand. We can only do what we can do. Please keep us in your prayers as you are always in ours.

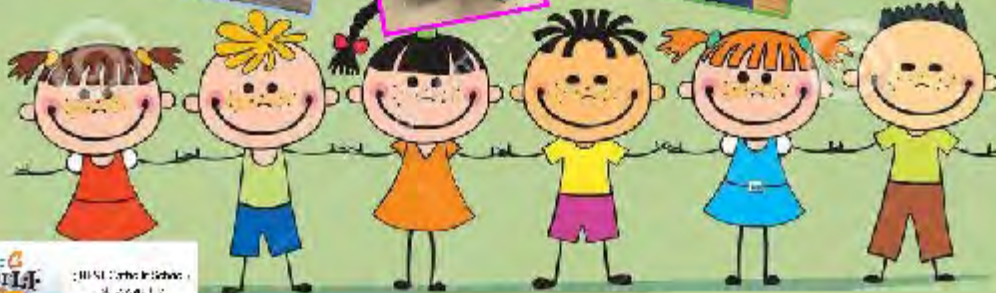


