From Fr. Mike's Desk

What is the Blessed Trinity? Better yet, who is the Blessed Trinity? This great mystery of our faith is the hardest for people to comprehend, and it is likewise difficult to explain to non-Christians. In fact, throughout the 2,024-year history of the Church, many people and groups have decided to ignore the Church's teachings and produce their own. In the early days of the Church, we saw the Arians who believed that Jesus was not really God. Arias (who was a priest), believed that Jesus was really a demigod who was a special creation by God and sent to earth to carry out the mission of salvation. Of course, this is a heresy (meaning mistaken belief), and the Council of Nicaea discredited it in 325 AD. Emperor Constantine called the Council because the controversy created by Arias and his disciples was causing bloodshed throughout the Empire. This council declared that anyone who did not believe that Jesus is God from God, Light from Light, True God from True God, is in error. So important are the Council's teachings that they were written into a creed (a statement of belief), and we say it at Mass every Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation.

Later, some would conceive the idea that Jesus was not a true human being, but the Second Person of the Trinity coming down to earth and pretended to be one of us. Yes, He was 100% God, but He was only taking on the appearance of being human. Therefore, He pretended to die on the Cross. This idea came about because those who pushed it could not understand how Jesus could be God and die on the Cross. Many churches still believe this heresy, and that is not all, even today, there are groups that have produced wrong ideas as to how they explain the Blessed Trinity. Some believe that Jesus is not God but a saint or someone special who was given the gift of eternal life because He sacrificed His life for us.

What is the true Orthodox teaching of the Church held by Roman Catholics, Eastern Orthodox, and Mainstream Protestants? There is One God who exists in Three Divine Persons: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Each Divine Person is equally God; each Divine Person is a facet of the One and Only True God. Wow, what does it mean for us? It means a great deal, but it is not easy to understand totally in this life. I hope that we will understand more in the next life, when we see God face to face, and experience the One God in Three Divine Persons. There is one trait that

this great mystery of faith reveals to us, and that is that God exists in a loving relationship of the Three Persons. In fact, we believe that this great love between the Father and the Son is that which generates the Holy Spirit. It is this love, which is the force behind all of Creation including us. How did we learn about the Blessed Trinity? We learned about it in many ways and one way was from Jesus Himself. Jesus was always speaking about His unique relationship with the Father, He spoke of how He and the Father were one. Jesus spoke about how He and the Father would send the Holy Spirit upon the Church to continue His work. We also know about the Blessed Trinity through the power, grace, and working of the Holy Spirit in the Church, and in our lives.

The feast was first proposed by St. Thomas Aquinas to focus and honor Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. Pope Urban IV established the feast as a solemnity for the whole Roman Church in 1246.

WHAT DOES THE SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI CELEBRATE?

Also known as the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, this feast honors Jesus Christ, really, truly and substantially present under the appearances of bread and wine. This presence happens through the change which the Church calls transubstantiation (“change of substance”), when at the Consecration of the Mass, the priest says the words which Christ Himself pronounced over bread and wine, **“This is My Body,” “This is the chalice of My Blood,” “Do this in remembrance of Me.”**
