

From Fr. Mike's Desk

"Lifting up His eyes to heaven, Jesus prayed saying: 'Holy Father, I pray not only for them, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word, so that they may all be one as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us.'"


Today's Gospel gives us a part of Jesus' High Priestly Prayer, offered by the High Priest on Holy Thursday night before He went out into the garden to pray and was subsequently arrested. At the beginning of this prayer, which is not part of today's passage, Jesus prays especially for the Apostles and places before the Father that He was not praying for the world (remember for John the world means human society which tries to exist without God) but was for His Apostles. He prays for them because He is going to send them out so they could change the world. Jesus also prays that the Apostles will be able to share in the joy that Jesus has in His relationship with the Father. For to share in this joy will give them part of what they need to go out and spread the Good News. Today's passage tells us that Jesus is extending His prayer beyond the Apostles to all of those who believe in what they are preaching. Our Lord has complete faith in His Father and complete faith in the ones who He will send out because they are the Father's gift to Him. Jesus has this faith in God and the Apostles even though He knows He is about to face the cross.

In this prayer, Our Lord ask that we live in unity. Sometimes this is extremely hard for us to do, especially when it seems easier to point out our differences. While it is true that there are different Christian Congregations, which have real differences in practices and beliefs, it is also true that we have so much in common with each other especially God's love. As Jesus prays for us to be unified in His love, so has Pope Francis and the popes of the past few decades. They not only have prayed but have taken steps to focus on what we have in common and have stressed that in our relations with non-Catholic Christians. Likewise, Christian groups are reaching out to us and others to make a more unified spreading of the Gospel. But for this to happen and for Jesus' prayer to touch us we must change our hearts. Jesus' prayer for us, is a great gift and it is a great challenge as well.

Next weekend we celebrate Pentecost Sunday which is the last day of the Easter Season. We will, of course, celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles, the Blessed Mother, and the whole Church. What better way to conclude Easter then remembering how the Church was empowered to carry out the petitions of Jesus' High Prayer by the grace and power of the Holy Spirit. Do not forget to wear RED to show how we are indeed open to the fire, power, and love of God.

Liturgy of the Hours

Last week the bulletin contained an introduction to the Liturgy of the Hours, also known as the Divine Office. The Liturgy of the Hours is the official prayer of the Catholic Church. There are five canonical Hours; Office of Readings, Morning Prayer, Daytime Prayer, Evening Prayer and Night Prayer. Each of the 'hours' designates a marked period of time where we sanctify that part of the day with prayer. Priests, Deacons and many Religious are obligated to the daily recitation of the Liturgy of the Hours, and the lay faithful are encouraged to do so also.

Finding several times per day to stop and pray may not be possible for everyone. This being the case, start with the two most important Hours, or 'hinge Hours', which are Morning and Evening Prayer. There are numerous resources available to help you pray the Liturgy of the Hours, both in book form, and via websites and apps for your smartphone. Some of these resources are:

SAINT OF THE DAY

May 29th

Saint Julia Ledóchowska - foundress of the Congregation of the Ursuline Sisters of the Agonizing Heart of Jesus.

She was a prolific supporter of Polish independence which she often spoke about at conferences across Scandinavia, while she settled Russia for time in a open convents until her expulsion. But she found continued to convents Scandinavian countries and even translated a Finnish catechism for the faithful there while later founding her own order which she would later manage from Rome at the behest of Pope Benedict XV.

Pope John Paul II canonized her in Saint Peter's Square on 18 May 2003 before a crowd of 50,000 people.




