From Fr. Mike's Desk

"Jesus said to them, 'Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life...For my flesh is true food and my blood is real drink and who remains in me and I in him...the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever.'"

Today we celebrate the Great Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ in which Saint Paul reminds us that the bread we eat and the cup we drink is more than meets the eye. For in the bread and wine, we truly receive Jesus' Body and Blood. This is the real food and drink, which comes down from heaven to make us one with God (through our receiving of the Divine Son) and one with each other (through the power of the Holy Spirit). This heavenly food, unlike what our ancestors ate in the desert, feeds not the body but the soul. This cup of the New Covenant does more than guench our physical thirst, it fills our soul's every desire. This great Sacrament reminds us of the Pascal Sacrifice of Christ on the Cross which sets us free from sin, darkness, and spiritual death, and empowers us to remake the entire world in the image and likeness of Christ.

This great Feast of Corpus Christi also reminds us of the proper way to receive Jesus in the Sacrament. Blessed One can receive Communion on the tongue or in the hands. If you are receiving Communion on the tongue, please wait for the minister to say, "The Body of Christ." After your response, "Amen," which means yes, I believe, then please stick out your tongue so the Eucharist can be placed on it. By putting out your tongue you provide a proper platform to place the Sacred Host. Sometimes people just open their mouths without sticking out their tongues or they stick their tongue out just a little without opening their mouth. The result is the Host falls on the

floor, or you could pass germs to the minister. During this time of post-Corona Virus, we must take extra care not to do this, so please stick out your tongue and open your mouth, thank you. If you are receiving Communion in the hands, it must be both hands- one which provides the base, or the throne to place the King of Kings on. Use the other hand to lift the Blessed Sacrament to your mouth and then it is received with great reverence and love. Please do not use one hand, and please do not take the Host with just two fingers. This is important because it reminds us of who it is, we are truly receiving in our hearts and souls. Thank you!


