From Fr. Mike's Desk

We have fully entered the second half of Ordinary Time for this liturgical year. While the last two weekends we were in Ordinary Time, we focused on two of the Solemnities of the Lord, *Holy Trinity Sunday* and *The Body and Blood of Christ*. We rejoin the Gospel according to Mark which presents us with a controversy. It, of course, revolves around Jesus' ministry, specifically His ability to cast out demons. It also deals with Jesus' extended family and their problems with His ministry.

As we are told, *"The scribes who had come from Jerusalem said, 'He is possessed by Beelzebul,' and 'By the prince of demons he drives out demons.'"* They believed that Jesus' power came not from God, but through Jesus being in league with the Power of Hell. They want to press this argument so people will stop believing in Him. But Jesus refutes them with this parable. "How can Satan drive out Satan? If a kingdom is divided against itself that kingdom cannot stand. And if a house is divided against itself, the house will not stand." Jesus tells them clearly that even the power of Hell cannot be divided against itself or the devil's attempts to destroy us would fail.

This is what brings us back to our first reading where Satan makes his first attack against us, and unfortunately is successful. However, God would not allow us to stay captives to sin, and God did not stop loving us. Instead, He promised that in the fullness of time (God's time) God would deliver us from the power of Hell. He did so by becoming one of us, by suffering and dying on the Cross, so all sin and spiritual death would be destroyed for all time. This is where the end of today's Gospel comes into focus. Jesus said, *"Amen, I say to you, all sins, and all blasphemies that people utter will be forgiven them."* Jesus tells us that He came to do His Father's will, and that is to set us free from Sin!

But what about the next verse, *"But whoever blasphemies against the Holy Spirit will never be forgiven."* We must look at this with more than a surface look. What does He mean by this, and how can I possibly sin against the Holy Spirit? According to some scholars, the Spirit that Jesus is referring to is the Jewish understanding of the Holy Spirit. In Jewish thought, the Holy Spirit had two great functions. First, the Spirit revealed God's truth to us, and second, He enabled us to recognize the truth. The Holy Spirit enabled people to recognize God's truth within our lives. However, if a person refuses to exercise any of

God's gifts, he or she will be lost. If we turn away from the Spirit, we will not recognize what is true and start to believe that lies are correct and that causes sin. The sin gets worse as we give up seeking penance and reconciliation. However, this understanding of the Holy Spirit is only a partial understanding. It is not the greater understanding that the Church received at Pentecost. The Church is given a greater share, as it is the living Body of Christ and the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit. Therefore, it is truly harder for us to sin against the Holy Spirit, but if we lose sight of God's forgiveness, and do not believe in it we can be lost.

We will discuss the comment about Jesus' extended family at another time.
