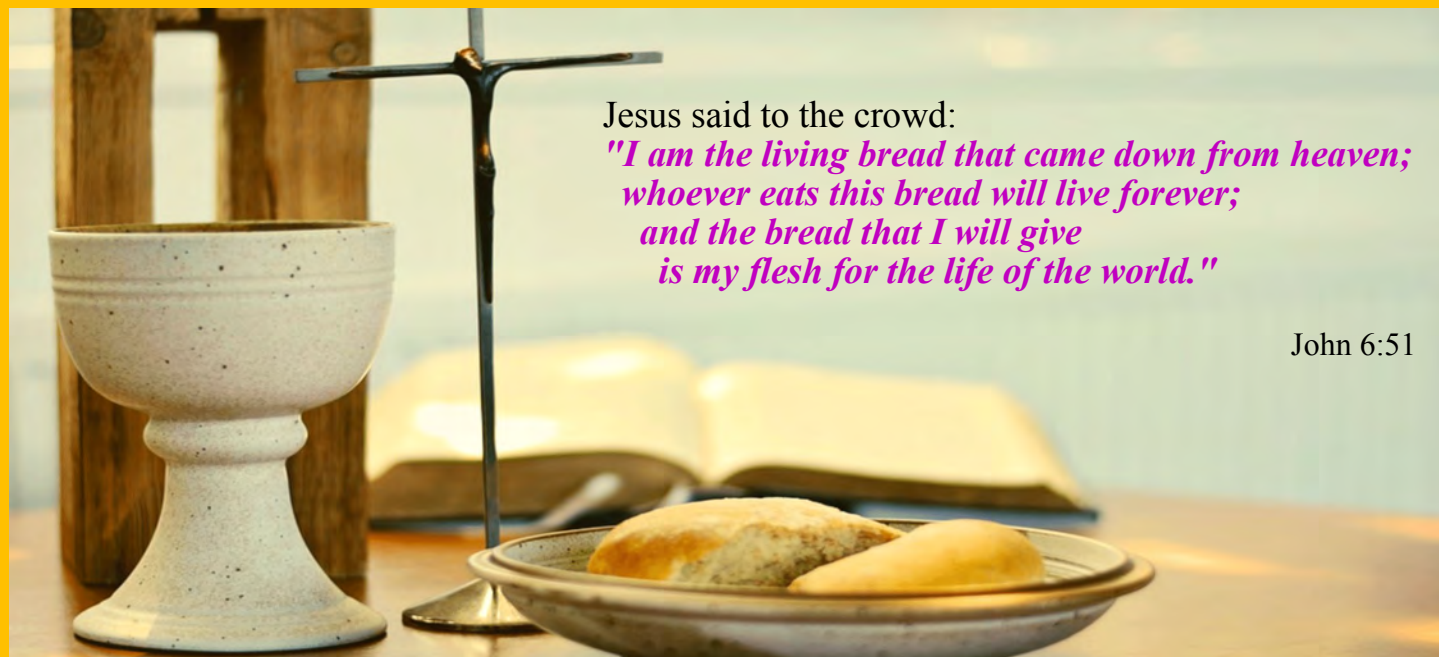

From Fr. Mike's Desk

“Jesus said to them, ‘Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever, eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life...For My flesh is true food and My blood is real drink and who remains in Me and I in him...the one who feeds on Me will have life because of Me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever.’”

Today we celebrate the Great Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ in which Saint Paul reminds us that the bread we eat and the cup we drink is more than meets the eye. For in the bread and wine we truly receive Jesus' Body and Blood. This is the real food and drink, which comes down from heaven to make us one with God (through our receiving of the Divine Son) and one with each other (through the power of the Holy Spirit). This heavenly food, unlike what our ancestors ate in the desert, feeds not the body but the soul. This cup of the New Covenant does more than quench our physical thirst, it fills our soul's every desire. This great Sacrament reminds us of the Pascal Sacrifice of Christ on the Cross which set us free from sin, darkness, and spiritual death, and empowers us to remake the whole world in the image and likeness of Christ.

This great Feast of Corpus Christi also reminds us of the proper way to receive Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. One can receive Communion on the tongue or in the hands. If you are receiving Communion on the tongue, please wait for the minister to say, “The Body of Christ.” After your response, “Amen”, which means yes, I believe, then please stick out your tongue so the Eucharist can be placed on it. With putting out your tongue you provide a proper platform to place the Sacred Host. Sometimes people just open their mouths without sticking out their tongues or they stick their tongue out just a little without opening their mouth. The result is the Host falls on the floor, or you could pass germs to the minister. During this time of the Corona Virus we must take extra care not to do this, so please stick out your tongue and open your mouth, thank you. If you are receiving Communion in the hands, it must be both hands, one which provides the base or the throne to place the King of Kings on, use the other hand to lift the Blessed Sacrament to your mouth and

then it is received with great reverence and love. Please do not use one hand, and please do not take the Host with just two fingers. This is important because it reminds us of who it is, we are truly receiving in our hearts and souls. Thank you!

Today, following the 11:30 Mass (weather and Viruses permitting) we are invited to participate in an age-old tradition of the Church, a Eucharistic Procession. We will process with the Blessed Sacrament on the Church grounds making two stops (one in front of the old Church now the Holy Family Room) and other in front of the statue of the Blessed Mother on Teibrook Avenue). Why do we do this you may ask? One reason is this is an outward sign of the unity we all share through Christ. Another reason is to remind people of the presence of Christ in the Eucharist. We also show others the great love that God has for us by giving us Himself in the Eucharist. When people see us in procession, they will certainly stop to think about God and their response to God in their life. Even if they think we are crazy, they will still think about God and how at least we respond to God in our lives, and that could change their life.

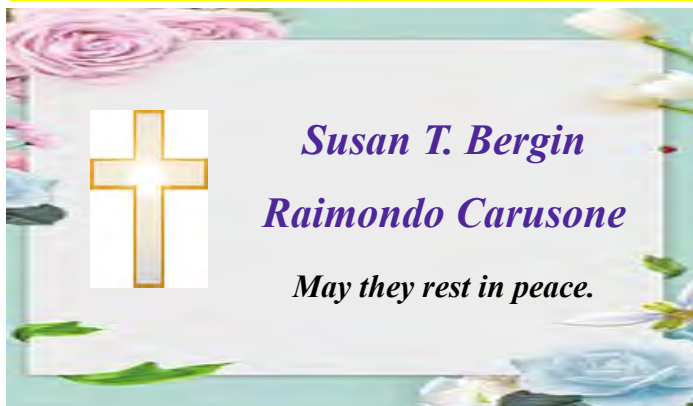

Fr. Mike's Letter for Week 12 of the Corona Virus Crisis

The following letter was posted last week, prior to The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, on the St. Edward's website as well as on Flocknote. The letter is reprinted here for those of you who do not have internet access.

This Sunday and next, we celebrate two of the three major Solemnities of Our Lord during Ordinary Time. They are Trinity Sunday and next week the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ. The focus of these two Sundays is two of the greatest mysteries of our Faith. We have been given some understanding of these mysteries, but it is not a complete understanding because frankly, they are beyond our Human Capacity, and I dare say even the full comprehension of the Angels. How can we fully comprehend the great mystery of how God exists as One God in Three Divine Persons: The Father, and The Son, and The Holy Spirit. While we may be able to recite the Theology behind the mystery or what we learned in the Catechism, it is still impossible to have a full understanding of the Trinity. Even when we see God face to face, He will remain a mystery. However, what we can say is that all of God is at work even now to help us achieve salvation and eternal life. All of God is always present to us to help us endure everything this world can throw at us. As we know these days the world is throwing a great deal at us and it never seems to end. The virus was not enough, the lockdown which we are still living with (hopefully which is getting lighter soon) was not enough. Now we have riots in the streets, which have overcome the legal rights of protesters, as some in the crowd advocated violence and destruction. When Lord will this end?

These are the times that try our hearts and our faith. These are the times when we must not give into despair, rather we should turn to God even more. I know we might believe that He is not listening, but He is! Look at the virus, there have been several breakthroughs with treatments that have speeded up healings for those who are suffering with the virus. Work is proceeding on a vaccine which will hopefully be developed soon, but the research is going much faster than it ever did in the past. The solution to the riots is simple, human beings must act like human beings who live in a civilized society. We must not forget the rules and morals that make America great. Those who break the law must be punished according to the law and must be held responsible for the violence and destruction they caused. The violence and destruction are not just to stores and cities, no it is the destruction of the people who own the stores or who work there and have had their lives totally disrupted. Violence and destruction effects all of us. God does indeed hear our prayers and we must continue to pray that those who are coming from other places to cause destruction will have a change of heart. We must not lose faith and we must ask God to fill our hearts with the grace and love of the Holy Spirit. When we allow the Spirit into our lives, we can face anything. Please let us also keep in our prayers George Floyd, his family, and all of those who have suffered from racial violence and hatred.

We are all frustrated, we all want our normal lives back, and in time this will happen. I also know we want our Church back, and maybe (more than maybe) if we write, call or email the Governor that will happen sooner. Next weekend we will celebrate, the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. We normally have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament on this day. Even if we are back to celebrating Mass on that day, we cannot have the procession. So, what we will do is have a drive by blessing with the Blessed Sacrament. We hope to do this starting at 10:30 AM, and the way we will do it is that you will remain in your car. Drive into the parking lot at Jackson Ave., stop in front of the Church for your blessing, and then proceed to Teibrook to exit. We will be there at least for an hour or until the flow of cars stop. If Mass resumes, we will then carry this out following the 11:30 Mass and will remain until the flow of cars stop.

Again, please do not lose heart, do not allow these trying times to destroy you and your faith. God The Father, The Son, and The Holy Spirit is indeed present and will be with us until the end of time and beyond. Remember Jesus told us that fear is useless, what is necessary is trust.

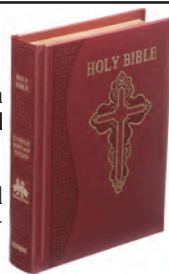
