From Fr. Mike's Desk

Last weekend we saw how hard it sometimes is to do God's work; how Ezekiel had to prophesy to a rebellious group, how St. Paul had to continue his work with much persecution and had to deal with the thorn of the flesh, and we saw how Jesus was rejected by the people of His hometown. Today we see more of these hardships, but even as the *Prophet Amos* is told to leave Bethel, he responds with, no matter what you say the Lord has sent me to prophesy and that is what I am going to do!

Today Jesus also sends out the twelve to proclaim the Good News. They were sent out without any money or provisions and were given the command to share everything Jesus had freely given to them. They were also told to make people aware that they should amend their lives, for the Kingdom of God is at hand. As a sign of this, they were able to cast out demons and cure sick people. The twelve were sent out two by two, and this serves as a model that the Church would always follow. The twelve were sent into a world where people wanted to listen to them and likewise, people who refused to listen. Guess what, we too have been sent!

This is Evangelization, and again this is what all Christians are supposed to do. We are to go out and share the Good News even when people do not want to listen to it. As we see today, Our Lord knew that there would be people who did not want to listen to the Apostles, that is why he tells them, "Whatever place does not welcome you or listen to you, leave there and shake the dirt off your feet in testimony against them." Jesus knows that we too will be treated in the same way, but keep in mind that we are not responsible for their listening to us or accepting what we say. What others do with the message is their business. Oh, sure we want them to listen; we want them to accept everything God has given us through Jesus, we want them to be saved. But their acceptance is not up to us, it is up to them. Also keep in mind that at times we are planting seeds, which may not sprout at the time they are planted, but later when conditions are right. This is why we must not get discouraged if people are not paying attention. Ask any teacher or parent, who thinks they did not do any good, and thought that their student or child was not listening to them. A few years later, (sometimes even 10 or 20 years) that student or child will come and say how much they learned and gained from that teacher, parent, or even a priest or deacon.

As Saint Paul tells us in his Letter to the Ephesians, God has chosen us in Christ to do all things, as he has called us all to Himself. So be empowered to go out and share the Good News for you have indeed been sent out. One of the ways you can respond to this call is by participating in one of the various ministries found at St. Edward's. Some of these ministries are; teaching in Religious Education, Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion either at Mass or to the Homebound or the Nursing Home or at Syosset Hospital, the Ministry of Consolation, Parish Social Ministry, or the St. Joseph's Prayer Group, or other organizations like, The Knights of Columbus, the Women's Guild, or Scouts. There are others, so there are many places where your gifts and talents can be used, and work can be done through your support of the Catholic Ministries Appeal; by your support of these ministries, we can help people throughout the Diocese.


