#### From Fr. Mike's Desk

Today's readings deal with property, riches, and human labor. Three things that we can all probably relate to, as we all seem to work hard in this world to get ahead and keep up with the neighbors. How many of us have to have the latest fashions or devices, or have the bigger house, the bigger car (although these days we would want to have the greenest house or car). As our first reading tells us to work for all these things is nothing but vanity!

Jesus echoes the author of Ecclesiastes when He tells the Parable of the Rich Man who had a bountiful harvest. The man asks the question as to what he should do with all that he had gained. He decided to tear down his barns and build larger ones. Then he will store all of his grain and other goods and be set for many years to come. Next he decides that he can sit back relax, eat drink and be merry. Who among us would criticize him for his thoughts? Who among us would not like to be in this man's shoes? It is as if he just won the Powerball or Mega Millions, and he is set for life! Nevertheless, even we know that most lottery winners do not keep their winnings for a long time, and they usually find that life is not easier for them in the end. In fact sometimes winning all that money creates problems and hardships that the person never wanted or had before. Jesus tells us that we should beware of apparently having all of earthly needs met like this or like the rich man in the parable. Notice what Our Lord says, "But God said to him, 'You fool, this night your life will be demanded of you; and the things you have prepared, to whom will they belong?" Thus will it be for all who store up treasures for themselves but are not rich in the matters of God." If we focus, only on the things of this world, and not the things of Heaven (morals, values, Gospel Truths) then we can lose Heaven! We can lose it because we have not sought it out. If we focus only on our lives here, we are not truly focusing on a relationship with God. We cannot be with God, if we do not seek Him, and the best way to do this is through Jesus Christ and follow His command to die to this world so we can rise with Him to the new life of the Resurrection.

As St. Paul tells us in his Letter to the Colossians, "Brother and sisters: if you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Think of what is above not of what is on earth. For you

have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ your life appears, then you too will appear with Him in glory. Put to death, then, the parts of you that are earthly: immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and the greed that is idolatry. Stop lying to one another, since you have taken off the old self with its practices and put on the new self, which is being renewed, for knowledge, in the image of the creator."

Now working hard for nice things, good food and the good life is not sinful, and is not a bad thing to do. However, working only for these and not allowing proper time for God, and to carry out our individual and communal part of Christ's mission is wrong and sinful. Where one's treasure is, so is their heart!

Do not forget the Parish Festival starting this week on Friday the 9<sup>th</sup> to Sunday the 11<sup>th</sup>. Enjoy the food, the games, the entertainment and the fireworks. See you there!






## A Message of Importance from Bishop Barron





St. Edward Religious Education is an 8-9year formation program. Public School Students are required to begin studies in grade1 and finish their classes in grade 8. We now have a Kindergarten level for those students who want a head start on their Religious Formation.

Preparation for First Holy Communion takes place in grades 1 and 2. Students receive their First Holy Communion in May of grade 2; First Reconciliation in March of grade 2. Grades 3 through 6 are required continuation years in students' religious education studies. Preparation for Confirmation takes place in grades 7 and 8. Students receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of grade 9.
