From Fr. Mike's Desk

"Which of you wishing to construct a tower does not first sit down and calculate the cost to see if there is enough for its completion?" Jesus is using a practical example, in fact, several in today's Gospel to call us to a very spiritual reality: the reality of our Salvation! Jesus points out how we are all very wise when it comes to making a decision about the steps we take to get along in this life. If we are going to make a large purchase, we usually look at our financial situation, we look at all of the options available, and we make the best choice. We also remember if I by one item I may not be able to buy another item of what we believe we need. Or, perhaps if it comes to a career move or an educational opportunity for a loved one or ourselves, we might look into the cost of time and money. Or maybe it is time to retire or leave our big house, we might try to look at all of the angles and do our best to make the right decision.

Do we do this when it comes to our spiritual/faith lives, or do we say what can we do? Perhaps we may say I will cross that bridge when I come to it. Of course, some may ask; how can I plan for this part of my life? Well, Jesus is telling us we need to plan, because if we wait to decide when we cross that bridge, we might discover that the bridge leads us to a place we do not want to go; and the bridge could be on fire! So how do we plan? It is not as hard as we think. Luke's Gospel gives us one way and that is to renounce all of our possessions. Renounce them and give them up if you can, but if you cannot give them up, then do not let them control your life. Do not be attached to them or the things of this world, for they are worthless and cannot be taken into the next life. Yes, we need things to exist in this world (food, clothing, housing, transportation, communication, even fun and entertainment) but many people have more than they need and many try to get more and more; never thinking that they have enough.


Maybe wealth and possessions are not your problem. Maybe the problem is how we see others. Do we see Christ in our brothers and sisters, or are we too caught up looking for their shortcomings? Are we too quick to judge or do we try to love as Jesus loves? Do we attend to our prayer life or are we caught up in the demands and details of this life, and we forget to thank the one who made this all possible? Do we allow God to be God and the focus of our lives? Or do we try to

be God and call every shot, thinking we are in control? By asking these questions of ourselves, we are trying to take the right actions, if we find we do not like the answers. So if we find this we must plan better, and the only way to do this is to turn to Christ. Now we know that there are times when we have turned to Christ and we still fail; do not worry, what this means is we have entered into the struggle to try to do what is right. God truly understands and appreciates that we are trying our best, and with the help of the Holy Spirit, the intercession of the Blessed Mother and all of the saints, as well as the prayers of the whole community we can bear our Cross and take the right bridge, the one that is not on fire!

Please keep in your prayers our young people who are preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Yesterday the first half of the class were on retreat and on September 21, the second half of the class will be on retreat to prepare themselves. Please keep them, their sponsors and their families in your prayers so they can truly become good adult members of the Church.



The pocket prayer shawls have been crafted with intention and love and that anyone in need of a prayer is welcome to take one. A basket of these shawls is in the vestibule for you.


