# The Readings for the Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

## Reading 1 - Wisdom 2:12, 17-20

The wicked say:

Let us beset the just one,  
because he is obnoxious to us;  
he sets himself against our doings,  
reproaches us for transgressions of the law  
and charges us with violations of our training.

Let us see whether his words be true; let us find out  
what will happen to him. For if the just one be the son  
of God, God will defend him and deliver him from the  
hand of his foes. With revilement and torture let us put  
the just one to the test that we may have proof of his  
gentleness and try his patience. Let us condemn him to  
a shameful death; for according to his own words, God  
will take care of him.

## James 3:16-4:3


Beloved:

Where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there is

Where do the wars and where do the conflicts among

do not ask. You ask but do not receive, because you  
ask wrongly, to spend it on your passions.

## Gospel – Mark 9:30-37

Jesus and his disciples left from there and began a  
journey through Galilee, but he did not wish anyone  
to know about it. He was teaching his disciples and  
telling them, "The Son of Man is to be handed over  
to men and they will kill him, and three days after  
his death the Son of Man will rise." But they did  
not understand the saying, and they were afraid to  
question him. They came to Capernaum and, once  
inside the house, he began to ask them, "What were  
you arguing about on the way?" But they remained  
silent. They had been discussing among themselves  
on the way who was the greatest. Then he sat down,  
called the Twelve, and said to them, "If anyone  
wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the  
servant of all." Taking a child, he placed it in the  
their midst, and putting his arms around it, he said  
to them, "Whoever receives one child such as this in  
my name, receives me; and whoever receives me,  
receives not me but the One who sent me."

## From Fr. Mike's Desk

As we look at our Old Testament reading from the Book of Wisdom, and today's Gospel from Mark we can see why the liturgists put these two readings together for this Sunday. Remember, except for the Easter Season, when the first reading comes from the Acts of Apostles, the first reading comes from the Old Testament, and it matches (in some way) the Gospel for the day. The connection can be seen when this passage takes on a prophetic tone relating to the Messiah, when it states, *"Let us beset the just One...He sets Himself against our doings."* *"For if the just One be the Son of God, God will defend Him and deliver Him from the hands of His foes... Let us condemn Him to a shameful death; for according to His own words, God will take care of Him."* Now compare this to what Jesus tells the Apostles in today's Gospel, "The Son of Man is to be handed over to men and they will kill Him."

Yes, they seem to work together, however, the human author of Wisdom did not intend this to be a prophecy about the Messiah. He wrote it to tell us about human nature and human weakness. Look at many of the saints in our Church's history, the prophets of old, and any great person in this world's history that worked for the good of others. So many times, people have tried to take them down, or look for flaws in their lives and the author of Wisdom is asking why? Why do we not rally behind these good people? Why do we not immediately follow their example? Perhaps it comes out of fear of being hurt because we believe that not everyone is trustworthy. We know of so many "con" men throughout history who at first looked good but turned out to be bad. People like Caesar, Napoleon, Hitler, and you can add your own names. So, while we should be careful at the beginning, why is it after the person has showed him or herself to be good, so many still go against him or her? Perhaps it comes from jealousy, or from fear that we could never be as good as that person. So, Wisdom's author warns us of this behavior and tells us to avoid it! Once we know that the person is truly good and has been sent by God, we should try to follow him or her. We should try to follow the Divine behavior and listen without doubt.

If only the teachers and leaders of the people during Jesus' time, had understood Wisdom's lessons, perhaps their response to Jesus would have been different. Even the Apostles did not

understand that lesson when they argued amongst themselves as to who was the greater. They perhaps allowed their fears to get the best of them, as they thought they were going to be left behind. But this is not what it's meant to be one of Christ's followers. If we have totally accepted Christ in our lives, then we must work for the good of all, and we must do it together. That is why Jesus places the child in their midst and tells them, "Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me; and the One who sent me." Why the Child? In Jesus' day a child was considered the property of his or her father, and the child owned nothing and did not have the power to control their lives. So, if Christ's Disciples act as innocently and as powerless as a child, they will in fact gain everything. Not earthly power and authority, but heavenly power and authority. So, let us follow the advice of Jesus, Wisdom's author and the Holy Spirit and follow the good person who is Jesus!


Please accept my deepest thanks for your prayers and continued financial support for our senior priests residing at St. Pius X Enriched Living Facility.

# EXTRAORDINARY MINISTER of HOLY COMMUNION

## Training Opportunities—Fall 2021



*Extraordinary Ministers  
of Holy Communion*

This training is required for **all** those who are beginning as Ministers. This “BASIC” training is required for **all** who wish to serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Those who wish to minister in hospitals, nursing homes and to the homebound are required to attend “SPECIALIZED” training in addition to BASIC training. One **must** attend BASIC training prior to SPECIALIZED training.

Plans for SPECIALIZED training will be shared in a separate communication

## How to Register for Extraordinary Minister Training

Each pastor who has qualified candidates he wishes to be trained as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion must send a nomination letter to Bishop Barres requesting the training. One letter from each parish is fine, as long as each individual attending is named on it. This letter must be received one week prior to the training date requested. This letter must indicate the date and location of the training session each person(s) will attend.

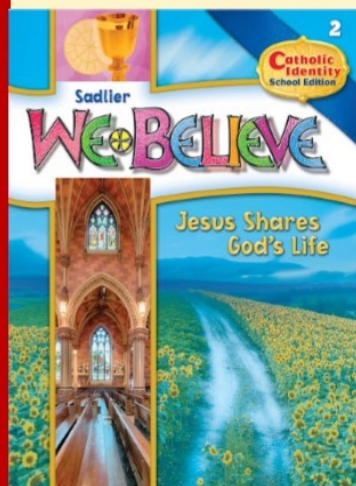


St. Edward's Religious Education is an 8 year faith formation program. Public School Students are required to begin their religious studies in grade 1 and finish their classes in grade 8.

Preparation for the reception of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion takes place in grades 1 and 2. Students will receive their First Reconciliation in March of grade 2 and their First Holy Communion in May of grade 2. Grades 3 through 6

are required continuation years for students in their religious education studies. Preparation for Confirmation occurs in grades 7 and 8. Students will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of grade 9.

After a year of virtual learning due to the pandemic, we are planning to resume in- school classes for religious studies this coming fall. Our scheduled opening date for Sunday classes is September 26th with weekday classes scheduled to begin the following week.

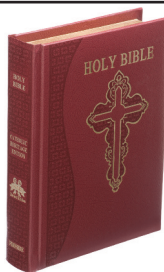
