

From Fr. Mike's Desk

A steward is defined as one who takes care of the property or business matters of another. That is exactly the person's job in today's Gospel, only he is not very good at his job. We are told by Our Lord that this person was about to be fired for squandering his master's property. As we are all familiar with this story (as we hear it every three years), we know that this unjust or dishonest steward will not dig ditches and that he is too proud to beg, so he finds a way to survive after he is let go. He cuts his commission to those who owe his master goods and services, so he will gain their favor and provide for his future employment.

His master, we are told, commended his dishonest steward for acting in such a way that will provide for his needs. Jesus tells this story in order to make several points that we, His Church, must consider. We are to follow the example of the dishonest steward. Now Jesus is not telling us to become dishonest people, but He is telling us to use the things of this world to benefit and spread the Gospel. We should use every opportunity, media tool, and whatever resources that are available to help convert those who only live their lives focused on this world. Yes, we are to use the things of this world to survive in it, but we must be careful not to let them control us. For if we get so caught in the things of this world, and start working for them, instead of merely using them, they become our masters and our total focus.

As Jesus warns us, "...No servant can serve two masters. He will either hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and mammon." This is one of life's greatest challenges. For it is indeed arduous to keep the balance between our spiritual life and the needs we have to meet in our physical life. We cannot do it on our own; we need the help of God to make sure that we focus on serving the right master. We accomplish this through prayer, receiving the Sacraments, reading and praying with Scripture, practicing the Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy, and following the Precepts of the Church. All of these help us to strengthen us and keep us on the right track.

During this time of the year, we start our **Religious Education Classes**; last week we blessed the Catechist (on Catechetical Sunday) and they are ready to go. Please keep our

catechists, our students and their families in your prayers that they may be open to learning about their faith, that they may learn about their relationship with Jesus and how that is so much more important than the things of the world. Help them to learn at an early age how to balance life in this world with their focus on the life that is to come

Please keep in your prayers our young people who are preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Yesterday they were on retreat to prepare themselves. Please keep them, their sponsors and their families in your prayers so they can truly become good adult members of the Church.

We conclude with this prayer for the Universal Church: God our Father, by the promise you made in the life, death, and resurrection of Christ, your Son, you bring together in your Spirit, from all the nations, a people to be your own. Keep the Church faithful to its mission: may it be a leaven in the world renewing us in Christ, and transforming us into your family. We ask this through our Lord, Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives, and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God forever and ever. Amen






