From Death to New Life

The Readings for the Twenty-sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Reading 1 - Numbers 11:25-29

The LORD came down in the cloud and spoke to Moses. Taking some of the spirit that was on Moses, the LORD bestowed it on the seventy elders; and as the spirit came to rest on them, they prophesied.

Now two men, one named Eldad and the other Medad, were not in the gathering but had been left in the camp. They too had been on the list, but had not gone out to the tent; yet the spirit came to rest on them also, and they prophesied in the camp. So, when a young man quickly told Moses, "Eldad and Medad are prophesying in the camp," Joshua, son of Nun, who from his youth had been Moses' aide, said, "Moses, my lord, stop them." But Moses answered him, "Are you jealous for my sake? Would that all the people of the LORD were prophets! Would that the LORD might bestow his spirit on them all!"

Come now, you rich, weep and wail over your impending miseries. Your wealth has rotted away, your clothes have become moth-eaten, your gold and silver have corroded, and that corrosion will be a testimony against you; it will devour your flesh like a fire. You have stored up treasure for the last days. Behold, the wages you withheld from the workers who harvested your fields are crying aloud; and the cries of the harvesters have reached the ears of the Lord of hosts. You have lived on earth in luxury and pleasure; you have fattened your hearts for the day of slaughter. You have condemned; you have murdered the righteous one; he offers you no resistance.

Gospel – Mark 9:38-43, 45, 47-48

At that time, John said to Jesus, "Teacher, we saw someone driving out demons in your name, and we tried to prevent him because he does not follow us." Jesus replied, *"Do not prevent him. There is no one who performs a mighty deed in my name who can at the same time speak ill of me. For whoever is not against us is for us. Anyone who gives you a cup of water to drink because you belong to Christ, amen, I say to you, will surely not lose his reward. Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him if a great millstone were put around his neck and he were thrown into the sea. If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter into life maimed than with two hands to go into Gehenna, into the unquenchable fire. And if your foot causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter into life crippled than with two feet to be thrown into Gehenna. And if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out. Better for you to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye than with two eyes to be thrown into Gehenna, where 'their worm does not die, and the fire is not quenched.'"*

From Fr. Mike's Desk

Today we see jealousy and fear at work in our readings from the Book of Numbers and Mark's Gospel. In the Book of Numbers, Joshua is jealous for Moses because of Eldad and Medad, who missed the call to go to the gathering God assembled to help Moses govern the people and meet some of their other needs. He was upset, because at the time God sent the Holy Spirit on those who made the gathering, He also sent the Spirit upon Eldad and Medad. With that, the two began to prophesize just like the other 70 elders who God told Moses to gather. Joshua felt that they should not be allowed to do so since they purposely missed the gathering and were going against the authority of Moses and God. Yet Moses tells Joshua not to be upset on his account, after all, they were on the list of those chosen to help share Moses' burden. It seems that God freely gave them a share of the same spirit anyway. Moses tells Joshua he's his thinking wrongly, and would it not be miraculous if all the people would cry out for the Lord! Moses is telling Joshua, frankly, to think outside of the box.

Jesus basically is telling John and the other disciples to think differently and not be jealous or fearful for His sake. The fear comes from a common belief that people could drive out demons by using the name of someone more powerful (whether it is the name of a more powerful demon or the name of one who was sent by God). Keep in mind, they believed that illness was caused by demonic possession, and this is what John saw them doing. He believed they were using Jesus' name without permission or without any right to do so. The two using Jesus' name were correct, but they were not correct in their reasoning. Yes, they knew Jesus' name was powerful, but they did not have a full reason why. The two did not know that He was the Son of God and that He cast out demons under His own Divine Authority. Yet they still invoked His name. So, John, and the others were right to be upset at their misunderstanding. However, Jesus told John not to be upset because what ever one does in His name is doing the work of the one who sent Him.

The same goes for us, only hopefully we understand what and why we are doing things in Jesus' name. While we may not try to drive out demons, we should be trying to drive out sin and darkness from our own lives and in the lives of those who Jesus places in our path. And like

Eldad and Medad, we are on the list that God the Father sent out to all those who were to assist Jesus, our names were put on the list when we were baptized. And if it has been a while since we lived out our baptismal promises and commission there is still time.

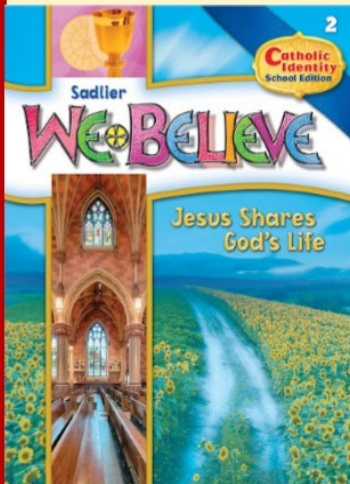
Registration Info for the 2021-2022 School Year



St. Edward's Religious Education is an 8 year faith formation program. Public School Students are required to begin their religious studies in grade 1 and finish their classes in grade 8.

Preparation for the reception of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion takes place in grades 1 and 2. Students will receive their First Reconciliation in March of grade 2 and their First Holy Communion in May of grade 2. Grades 3 through 6 are required continuation years for students in their religious education studies. Preparation for Confirmation occurs in grades 7 and 8. Students will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of grade 9.

After a year of virtual learning due to the pandemic, we are planning to resume in-school classes for religious studies this coming fall. Our scheduled opening date for Sunday classes is September 26th with weekday classes scheduled to begin the following week.

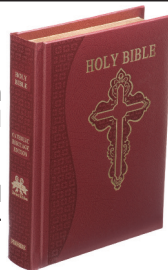
