From Fr. Mike's Desk

Have you ever said, "I will believe it, when God Himself comes down from Heaven and tells me!" Or perhaps, "God why don't you just come out and tell me what you want me to do!" Moreover, if you have said these or similar words, or know someone who has uttered them, and God gave an answer would you refuse to listen to God? I am sure most of us would say, "Of course not." However, this is not the case in our Old Testament reading, nor is it the case in today's Gospel. The Prophet Amos warns the people of the Northern Kingdom of their faults and they ignore him. They realize that he is God's prophet, and the words he speaks are God's words, yet they refuse to listen or change. Therefore, they will face utter destruction.

In the Gospel Jesus tells us the story of the Rich Man and Lazarus. The rich man refused to help Lazarus who sat at his door every day. He ignored Lazarus' needs, and thus he refused to listen to the Commandments and the many Jewish traditions, which held that the rich had certain obligations toward the poor. This parable also tells us of the greatest example of anyone refusing to listen to God. We see this as the rich man who is in a very bad place after he dies, asks Abraham to send Lazarus (who also died) to his father's house so he could warn the rich man's brothers as to what awaits them if they do not change. However, Abraham's answer is important for Jesus' audience to hear (2,019 years ago and today). Remember Abraham tells the rich man that his brothers have Moses and the Prophets, but for the rich man they were not enough. After all, he had them too, and he refused to listen. If someone like Lazarus would return from the dead, to correct his brothers they would listen. Now pay attention to what Abraham says. *"If they will not listen to Moses and Prophets, neither will they be persuaded if someone should rise from the dead."*

The intended audience for this parable was the Scribes and the Pharisees, who refused to listen to Jesus or acknowledge who He truly was. For if they had truly listened to Moses and the Prophets they would have correctly known that Jesus was the Messiah. Moreover, if they refused to believe when Jesus walked the earth, neither would they believe when He rose from the dead. This is of course true, for when the news of the Resurrection started spreading they refused to believe it and spread their own story that the Apostles took


Jesus' body. Unfortunately, too many people today refuse to listen to Jesus and some even refuse to believe in the Resurrection. Too many would rather live life on their own terms and do not care if they are doing right or wrong. They live like the rich man and ignore the problems of people throughout the world.

This is indeed a sad situation. As for us who do believe, what is it that we should do. We must try our best to listen to God. We are to pray that we will change the parts of our lives that need changing and we should pray for those who do not believe. We can try to engage them in conversation and try to help them see more clearly. Now we must keep in mind that they may not listen, and if they refuse to listen, do not lose heart or faith; they may in time come to eventually listen to your words and God's.

Please keep our young people in your prayers as they prepare to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on Saturday October 26, 2019 at 11AM or 2:30 PM. This year we are very happy to welcome our Bishop, the Most Rev. John O. Barres.
